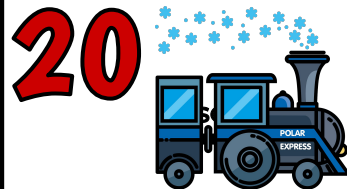

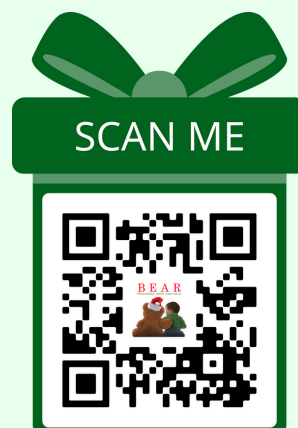

## Gifted and Talented Program Identification

### Notice to Parents of NEW and CURRENT Students in Cypress-Fairbanks ISD

Cypress-Fairbanks ISD provides Mid-year screening for students in grades 1 – 11 to receive gifted and talented services through the HORIZONS program if they are enrolled at a CFISD campus. Students whose referral is received by November 30, 2024, may be included in the Mid-year testing process and students may be referred at any time. Students must meet the following criteria:

- **The student has NOT participated in an identification assessment during the same school year.**
- **The student has NOT been previously identified as gifted and talented.**

**Note:** New students who have been previously identified as gifted and talented from out-of-state and Texas public or charter schools and recognized and accredited private schools are eligible to receive services in CFISD once previous GT placement can be verified and parent permission is provided. Parents must provide a copy of the student's notification of qualification and placement within the gifted and talented program from the former school district AND a copy of all test results used for screening. Testing will not be administered if the student has been previously identified.

Parents/guardians interested in requesting screening for their student to receive gifted and talented services should complete the online acknowledgement to include the characteristics of a gifted child, permission to test, and permission for services located in the Gifted and Talented link on the CFISD parent portal by the due date **November 30th**. ### Testing and Screening for the Gifted and Talented Program

- Testing will occur in the Spring between January and February 2025.
- *Student Score Reports* and notification of qualification/placement will be available for view in the parent portal of the Home Access Center.
- Students whose scores qualify for identification will begin receiving services the following school year upon confirmation of placement.
- Students whose scores do not qualify may not be referred again for testing until the next school year. (Students may test only once per year.)
- Students who do not qualify for services may appeal the placement decision to the campus Selection Committee. Information regarding the appeals process is available from the **elementary Counselor**.

**Note:** Appeals for entry should be based on significant advanced abilities consistently demonstrated in the classroom and supported by academic and performance data not evidenced by HORIZONS screening scores.

*Additional criteria for an appeal include:*

- *illness immediately before or during testing with documentation of the illness*
- *emotional duress due to a family crisis during testing with documentation*
- *accommodations not provided during testing for students with special needs*

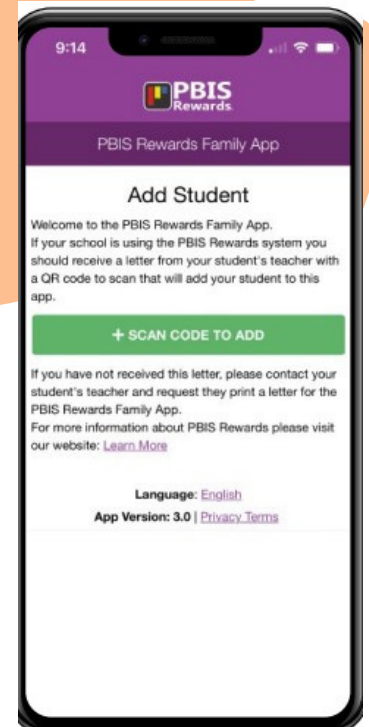


# PBIS Rewards

## FAMILY APP INFORMATION

### WHAT IS IT?

As part of the PBIS Rewards suite of apps, the free PBIS Rewards Family App allows parents and guardians to view student point totals, number of referrals, items purchased with points, and upcoming events for which points can be used.



### HOW DO I GET CONNECTED?

Once you download the app onto a smartphone, you can scan a QR code to activate a student in the app. This QR code is unique to each student and is provided to the parent via a letter from the school. The app confirms the QR code, allowing the parent to access to their student's point totals and progress as the school year goes along.



### STEPS TO GET CONNECTED

**1**

Download the PBIS Rewards Family app on your device.

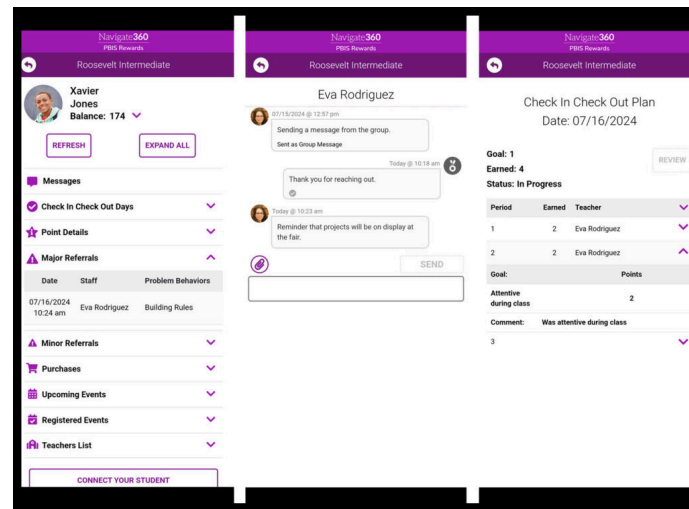


**2**

Wait for a text or email from your child's teacher which will include a link and QR code to help you get connected to your child.

**3**

- Communication**
  - Two-way messaging
- Points**
  - view teacher comments for points awarded
- Purchases made by student**
- Contact information for all teachers so parents/guardians can contact staff directly from the app.**



### WHY SHOULD I USE IT?

The PBIS Rewards Family App allows parents and guardians to track the progress and point totals of students. The parent/guardian can view the information for each child. The school can generate paper letters, emails, and/or text messages to connect parents and guardians with their students within the app.

### REMEMBER...

- This is an easy way to communicate with your child's teacher.
- Reinforce good behavior at home.
- Have conversations with your child about the behaviors and decisions that they make at school.

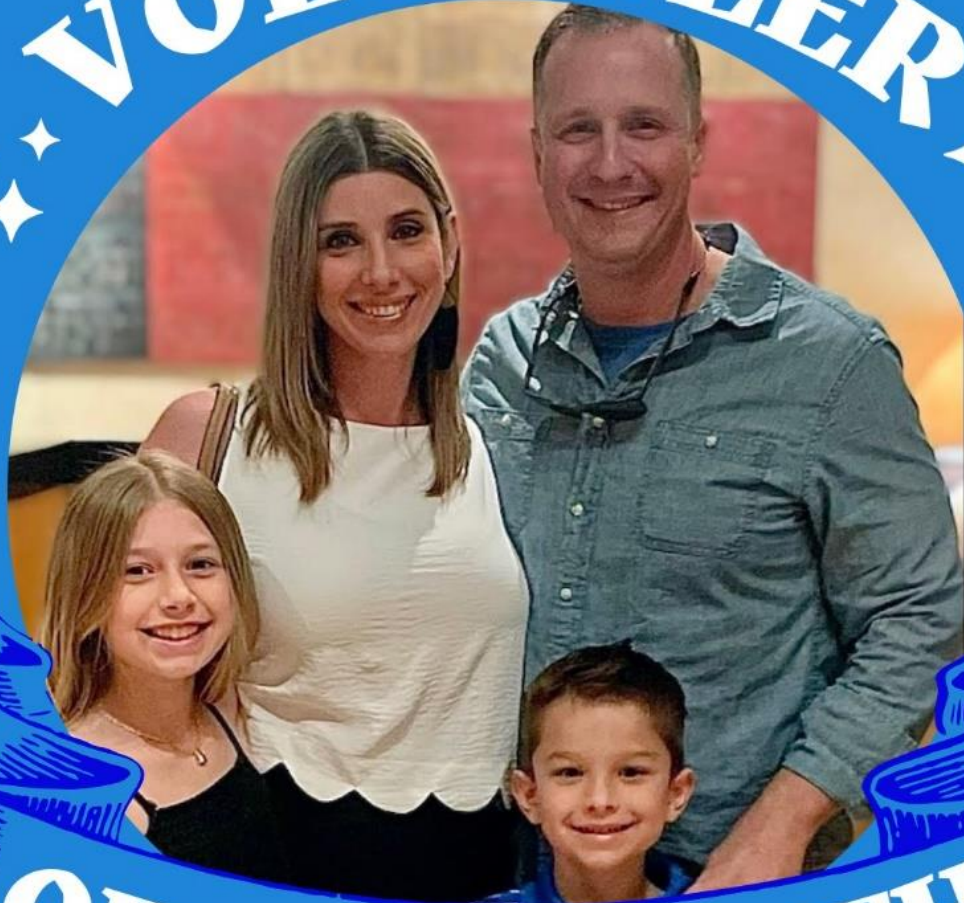
