SCHOOL OF GLOBAL STUDIES

- The goal of TWI is for all students to become biliterate and bilingual in Spanish and English while having high academic achievement.
- TWI classrooms are approximately 50% native Spanish speakers and 50% native English speakers
- Kindergarten starts at 80% of instructional time in Spanish
- TWI follows a dual language model with over 30-year of research backing its success. It is one of the most effective methods for English language learners to become proficient in English, while keeping their native language.
- TWI will expand to 7th grade at in the 2025-26 school year.
- Native English speakers can apply, via the lottery, for a TWI seat in Kindergarten only, as the linguistic demands in Spanish will be difficult if they do not begin in the early





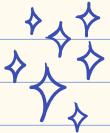

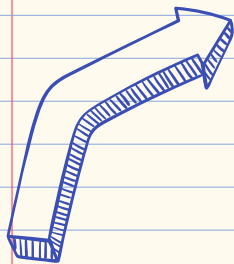


Living The Legacy School

King Arts is a K-8 magnet school that provides a continuous and tight knit educational, literary and fine arts experience for young scholars.

African-Centered Curriculum (ACC)

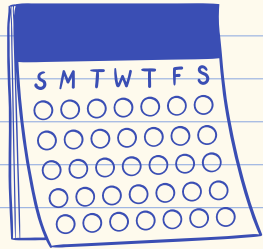


Oakton Elementary is home to the African-Centered Curriculum (ACC) program and a tight-knit community of scholars, veteran educators, and engaged families. The ACC program offers a nurturing environment designed to help students achieve academic success, independence and the cultural competence to live and learn in a diverse community.

Students in the ACC program learn the same curriculum as other D65 students along with the teaching and learning of the culture, heritage, and identity of people of African descent.

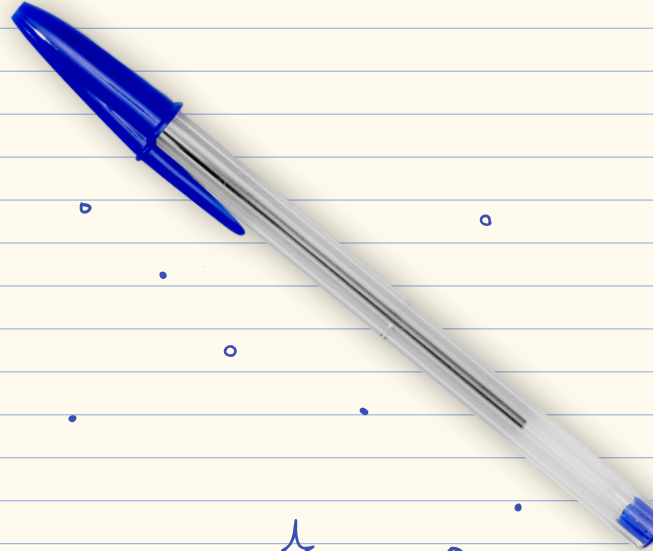
The application for the African-Centered Curriculum program is open to all K-1st grade across District 65.

Rice Education Center

Rice is a therapeutic day school program whose task is to provide emotional support and academic opportunities to children who have been unable to succeed in community school settings due to emotional, learning and behavioral difficulties.

Rigorous Individualized Specialized Program (RISE) at King Arts

RISE is a self-contained, special education program designed to provide a supportive and rigorous educational experience for students who present moderate to significant disabilities and require special education instruction for more than 50 percent of the school day.

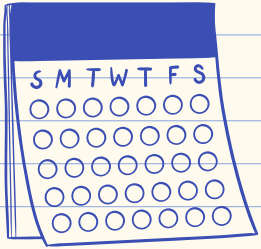
Park School (3-22 yrs)

Park is for students who could benefit from a self-contained educational facility for reasons of safety, health, and/or the need for an intensive therapeutic environment. At the core of the program are functional, realistic goals that assist with the transition from a school environment to that of the community.

Structured Teaching Education Program (STEP) at Lincoln, Lincolnwood and Washington (bilingual)

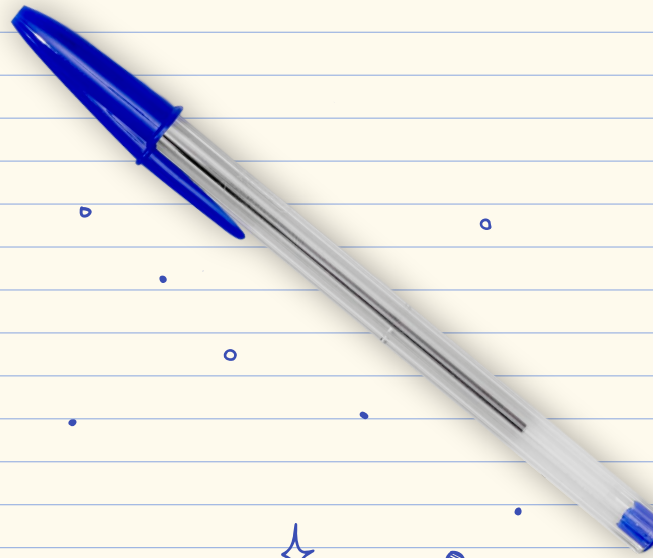
STEP is a self-contained, special education program primarily for students diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder.

When completing the online registration

What you will need to upload into the online registration

1. Copy of student's birth certificate.
2. Copy of ALL residency verification documents. (see next page).
3. If it is indicated another language is spoken at home, the student will be required to take a language exam.
4. If applicable - court documents and IEP/504.

Birth Certificate verification

All new Students

All new students' original birth certificates must be verified, in-person, by making an appointment with the Registration Department

You may also provide a passport, visa or other government-issued documentation of the child's identity, if the birth certificate is not available.



IL State Law

According to the Missing Children Records Act (325 ILCS 50/5), caregivers must provide a certified copy of the student's birth certificate to the school district within 30 days of enrollment.

1. Name of the adult registering the student
2. Address where the child lives
3. Most recent date (within 60 days)
4. Business name and logo
5. Documents must be from different sources

New and Kindergarten Registrations

The State of Illinois requires parents/guardians to present an original or certified copy of the birth certificate (visa or passport if the birth certificate is not available) IN-PERSON during Step 2 of the registration process.

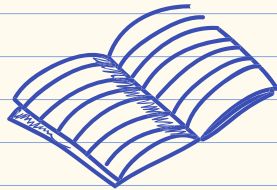
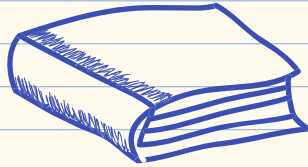
➤ The registration form is ongoing and will remain open the whole year
