# MINUTES

# June 7, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its budget and regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 7, 2010, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

Steven W. DeBerry, Chair James M. Spivey, Vice Chair Frances Reaves Tommy A. Blake Ann Long Shirley M. Threadgill

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and called for a motion to adopt the meeting agenda. Upon a motion by Mr. Spivey and a second by Mrs. Long, the agenda was adopted with unanimous approval from the board.

The opening devotional thoughts by Chairman DeBerry were from Mathew 5:21. When asked to do something, be faithful and trustworthy and do the very best you can. Show me a man who cannot do the little things, and I will see a man who also cannot be trusted to do the large things.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Star Elementary students, Lyza Jarvis and Ana DePaz.

Two individuals signed up for the public comment period.

The first person to speak was Bryan Dozier. He asked respectfully for the board to have a countywide search committee. Per Mr. Dozier, "We have people out there that would be a great help". One concern is that the newly chosen superintendent will be chosen by a board that will not be the same after the November election. This new board will have not had a choice in the decision.

The second person to speak was Ken Thames. He came to show his support of Ron Weaver. Mr. Thames thanked the board for working to keep our children safe, but he also wanted them to support the staff when they had done no harm.

The board then recognized the West Montgomery High School Golf 1A State Champions, Ethan Sasser, Jordan Taylor, Ethan Dennis, Drew Harkins, Charlie Maness, and Dylan Kennedy. Their coach, Lt. Col. Tom Oveby and assistant coach, Rick Peters were recognized along with their team. Another West Montgomery High School student, Herbert Robinson was recognized as the Track 1A 100-Meter Dash State Champion.

The West Montgomery High School HOSA State Conference Winners were Outstanding HOSA Chapter – 1<sup>st</sup> Place, Laura Watkins. Parliamentary Procedures Team – 2<sup>nd</sup> Place were Mistie Williams, Laura Watkins, Maitong Vang, Brittany Kirk, and Craig Little.

The 2009-2010 Montgomery County Schools Bus Drivers of the Year were recognized. They were from the East Side – Nancy Townsend, and the West Side – Lakita McDonald.

The Montgomery County Schools Making a Difference Award – High School Level personnel were recognized: Henry Panzer, Teacher/Athletic Director – WMHS and David Wooley, Teacher Assistant –WMHS.

With a motion from Mr. Blake , and a second from Mrs. Long, the board unanimously voted to hold consent agenda until after the closed session.

Allison Schafer from the North Carolina School Board Association spoke on the survey results gathered to gain some perspective on the search for a new superintendent from Montgomery County Schools. Dr. Donna Peters is retiring effective August 1, 2010. Steve DeBerry thanked all that had done the survey. Community input is very important to this process.

Sue Hatley introduced Vance Thomas from Star Elementary School. Star's curriculum focus is Star Student Council. Mr. Thomas introduced Melanie Lamonds and the Star Student Council, Lyza Jarvis, Ana Depaz, Raegan Brewer, Kayla Smith, and Terra Haynes, who worked through the process of setting everything up, starting with the election process, setting up committees, setting goals, and running a meeting. The Star Student Council group chose recycling as their project for this year. They played an active role in their school to make this happen. They took leadership roles and made it happen.

Sue Hatley then presented the preliminary 2010 Grade 10 Writing results and the EOG update. More information will be forthcoming at July, 2010 meeting.

Sue Hatley and Kevin Lancaster presented the 2010-2011 Federal application to be approved. This included: Career-Technical Education, Title I, Title II, Title III, and Migrant Application. With a motion from Mr. Blake, and a second from Mr. Spivey, the board unanimously approved all applications.

Frank Fiorella presented the USDA Fresh Fruits and Vegetables Grant for Candor Elementary, Mt. Gilead Elementary, Page Street Elementary, Troy Elementary, Star Elementary, and Green Ridge Elementary. Our six schools are out of 106 chosen in North Carolina. Training will be provided to learn all about this program. It must be approved every year and the rules change for this Federal program. Frank Fiorella then asked for the board's approval on the 2010/2011 school service food procurement plan. This way of procurement gives smaller counties a group of systems which have lower prices and get more variety in items. With a motion from Mrs. Long, and a second from Mrs. Reaves, the board approved the procurement plan unanimously.
