MINUTES

July 1, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its budget and regular monthly meeting on Thursday, July 1, 2010, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

Steven W. DeBerry, Chair James M. Spivey, Vice Chair Almetta Armstrong Tommy A. Blake Ann Long Shirley M. Threadgill

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and called for a motion to adopt the meeting agenda. Upon a motion by Mr. Spivey and a second by Mr. Blake, the agenda was adopted with unanimous approval from the board.

The opening devotional thoughts by Chairman DeBerry were from Mathew 22:31. This 4th of July our American Flag, Old Glory, will be more displayed. We will be playing ball, eating at picnics, faces will smile because of this our 4th of July and our spirit of freedom. We pay our respect to our Declaration of Independence. Freedoms can be lost, one by one or all at once. We, the people, determine it's course.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Chairman DeBerry.

With no one signing up for the public comment period, the meeting progressed to the recognition portion of the meeting.

Chairman DeBerry on behalf of the Montgomery County Board of Education presented the retiring superintendent of Montgomery County Schools, Dr. Donna Peters, a plaque that recognized Dr. Peters for her contributions to Montgomery County Schools. Many accomplishments and positives have happened through strong leadership, vision, and direction, in leading us the last four years. Thank you, Dr. Peters from the children of Montgomery County.

With a motion from Mr. Spivey , and a second from Mrs. Long, the board unanimously voted to hold consent agenda until after the closed session.

Sue Hatley and Ben Grindstaff then presented the updated preliminary 2009-2010 Grade State accountability report. After looking at these results, a plan has been put together for science tests to improve.

David Cassidy presented an agreement between the US Air Force JROTC Program and West Montgomery High School which allows them to use pellet guns under the supervision of the West Montgomery High School Hunter Safety team advisor. With a motion from Mrs. Long, along with a second from Mr. Spivey, the board unanimously approved this agreement.

Beth Blake presented the NC Department of Public Instruction, AIG Local Plan for 2010-2011. Thirteen is standard this year and for next year. Teachers will be updated on the AIG standards and resources. We will rotate the professional development for our teachers. There will be an AIG committee with parents, board members, and teachers. With a motion from Mr. Spivey, along with a second from Mrs. Long, the board voted their approval unanimously.

Frank Fiorella asked for the approval of the 2010-2011 School Food Service bids. With a motion from Ms. Armstrong, along with a second from Mr. Blake, the board unanimously approved the bids as shown.

Sue Hatley introduced Graham Fox who gave an update on the I 3-D technology classroom. BRAC has furnished two systems in the classroom at East Montgomery High School. The portable systems went to West Montgomery High School. There is a six week internship for students from both schools. Opportunities with business and industry, is there for our students. Companies such as Purdue Farms and General Electric have projects for us. These opportunities can be a revenue source for the program. The students wrote a business plan to qualify for the grant. East and West Montgomery High Schools are working together. Their company name is MOCO LOCO. The board is invited to visit the I 3-D technology classroom.

Graham Fox also asked for the board's approval on the plan for an East Montgomery High School Technical Education automotive storage area. No school funds will be needed with this plan. With a motion from Mr. Spivey, along with a second from Mrs. Long, the board unanimously approved this plan.
