MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

MINUTES

December 6, 2010

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, December 6, 2010, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and called for a motion to adopt the meeting agenda. Upon a motion by Mr. Blake, and a second by Mrs. Long, the agenda was adopted with unanimous approval from the board.

The opening devotional thoughts by Chairman DeBerry were from the Book of Deuteronomy. By rewinding the past we can regain the future. Remember the past and you will capture the spirit of Christmas. Memories come in taste, smell, and visions of things we remember and cherish. Remember the celebrations of family. Remember and wonder if our children of today are given good memories for their futures.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by East Montgomery High School students, Nikki Hunsucker and Kedric Marshall.

Chairman Steve DeBerry suspended the regular meeting to Montgomery County School Board Attorney, Max Garner to officiate over the election of the Montgomery County Board of Education Officers for year ending December, 2011. Mr. Garner asked for nominations for Board Chairman, Tommy Blake nominated Steve DeBerry, along with a second from Shirley Threadgill. There were no other nominations. The board unanimously approved Steve DeBerry as Board Chairman. and asked for nominations for Vice Chairman. Shirley Threadgill nominated Tommy Blake, along with a second from Bryan Dozier. There were no further nominations. The board unanimously approved Tommy Blake as Vice Chairman. Chairman DeBerry then resumed his role as Board Chairman.

With no one signing up to address the board, the meeting moved on to recognitions.

The Montgomery County Schools Community Partnership Award was awarded to Myron and Barbara Dice, Co-Pastors of Sandhills Circuit United Methodist Church for their contributions at Star Elementary. Unfortunately they were not able to attend due to illness.

Marvis Rorie, East Montgomery High School Band Director and Students; Amber Byrd, Nikki Hunsucker, Kedric Marshall, LuAnn Yancey won the East Montgomery High School Band Competition, 3rd Place Overall, 2nd Place for Music and the Recipient of the "Espirt de Corps" Award

Star Elementary Principal, Vance Thomas won Montgomery County Schools' 2010-2011 Principal of the Year.

Pat Parrish, Troy Elementary teacher is Montgomery County Schools' 2010-2011 EC Teacher of Excellence.

2010 Bright Ideas Grant Recipients are: Nita Thompson, Green Ridge Elementary School; Debra Knowles, West Middle School; Angie Tofflemeyer, West Middle School; and Teresa Simmons, Candor Elementary School.

Outgoing Montgomery County Board of Education Board Members James Spivey and Frances Reaves were recognized for their contributions to the education system of Montgomery County.

Chairman DeBerry called for approval of the consent agenda to be held until after the closed session. The board unanimously approved the motion.

The curriculum focus was presented by East Montgomery High School with their foundations for academic success. With 26 probationary teachers, this new approach is to foster and support these teachers. There is a team of other teachers as mentors to get help from and assistance from when needed. This will reduce the turnover rate of teachers.

The teachers at East Montgomery High School work together to cultivate parent and student involvement through committees, book study, Saturday Academy, and whatever it takes to help students succeed. Teachers volunteer their time when needed. They build the relationships with parents and students needed to succeed. East Montgomery High School is becoming a Professional Learning Community. There are 51 certified teachers who are the foundation for this.

Superintendent Dale Ellis then gave an update on the Professional Learning Communities happening in Montgomery County Schools. Keep the house model structure as a focus. It has been explained at all schools. Some training was started in November at Page Street Elementary and has gotten great feedback. Students are involved in their own learning. It is a work in progress with a lot of excitement from teachers and students for this way of learning. High expectations will give us the results we need. We should see results at the end of this year and more for next year.

Graham Fox presented the group of middle school students who are involved in using the 3-D System for video game creation. Equipment has come from the Golden Leaf Grant. The course is Scientific Technical Evaluation. We are the first in the state to have this course for middle school students. They have proven that they can do it. This is a field they can use as a career basis.

Dale Ellis asked that the 2010-2011 Montgomery County Schools Calendar be amended for schools to close two hours early on December 17, 2010. With a motion from Bryan Dozier, along with a second from Sandra Miller, the board unanimously approved the amendment.

Frank Fiorella presented the Montgomery County Schools Universal Breakfast Pilot Program. This is recommended for schools that are 70% free lunches. With all students included we will gain participation as now only 55% of students are taking advantage of the free breakfasts. Each school will have its own plan of implementation. With a motion from Bryan Dozier, and a second from Tommy Blake, the board voted unanimously to accept this program.

Kevin Lancaster then presented the policies for the board to approve after waiting the 30 days required. With a motion from Tommy Blake, along with a second from Shirley Threadgill, the board unanimously approved the following policies for change.

Dale Ellis gave his superintendents update. Montgomery County Schools' dropout rate has shown a downward trend for the first three months of this year. The Race to the Bottom information shows that North Carolina is number 42 in the nation for what it spends on its K-12 students in public school. We must look at what the state is cutting with education. We will continue to fight this reduction of funding. Education must be funded first. We want success for all students, but we must achieve that with having less.

With the first 90 days, we have looked at what we need to accomplish, had listening tours from students, teachers, staff, and the community. This will be used in establishing the framework and it will be presented in January what the plan will be. I am asking that we

schedule a time for a midyear review to see what progress we need to do with the focus on results.

Chairman DeBerry asked for a motion to adjourn to closed session for discussion of personnel. With a motion from Bryan Dozier, and a second from Sandra Miller, the board unanimously approved the adjournment to closed session.

After returning from closed session, Chairman DeBerry reconvened the meeting.
