MINUTES

May 2, 2011

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, May 2, 2011, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and asked for a motion to amend the agenda by deleting the budget hearing portion at this time. With a motion from Ann Long, and a second from Sandra Miller, the agenda was adopted with this change with unanimous approval from the board.

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The meeting then progressed to Green Ridge Elementary, with principal, Terry Jordan, along with staff, Irene Robleto, Matt Wolf, Brandy Whitley, and Phillip Brown, presenting "Technology Showcase". Presentations on Play-away, which helps with reading skills and gives opportunities for reading practice with small groups. They can be taken home and have English and Spanish language, so that parents can participate. Also showcased are flip cameras to monitor and help children's reading skills. They can read and play it back to see what they have learned. They also can be taken home. Active slate was also brought forth as a tool which you use the whiteboard, but with sound and motion to bring things to life. It is very interactive with a variety of resources, including Blogs and WIKI. Active Expression is also another tool that is used to test student knowledge.

Superintendent Ellis presented his findings about the need for text books. In doing a survey of needs for text books we see the need of text books for West Montgomery High School

and West Middle School. Most schools have what they need in this area according to their feedback. There were questions from teachers on whether they have to use the text books for home work. The instructions design belongs to the teacher. They need to use the data for the good of the student. At some point they need to have reinforcement of the lessons. We will make sure that the schools have the textbooks and technology to do what is needed. We want to make sure there is some traditional teaching as well as the technology portion. The data should drive the course. No one went without a textbook because of funds.

Superintendent Ellis presented the National Teacher Day 2011 Proclamation for the board's confirmation. With a motion from Bryan Dozier, along with a second from Shirley Threadgill, the board unanimously approved this proclamation.

Feedback from the community area advisory meetings was given by Superintendent Ellis. The meeting that was scheduled at Troy Elementary was better attended than when we have them at the middle or high schools. We will consider having all of them at elementary schools. A back to school rally is planned for August to greet parents and students. Details will follow for this event.

Kevin Lancaster presented the policies that were presented at the April board meeting for approval. With a motion from Bryan Dozier along with a second from Sandra Miller, the board unanimously approved these policies.

Superintendent Ellis in his comments congratulated Kathy Johnson and the finance department for their award of excellence. We see some problems on the horizon with our budget. Some massive cuts have hung education out to dry. We see some \$500,000 possibly cut from the county. We will get to the tier III cuts. We have dealt with \$6,500,000 to \$4,900,000 this year. Those funds are well managed when they get here. Representative Justin Burr is putting Stanley County on the list for maintaining the Stanley County schools on a 4 day, 1 hour extra per day. We will look at this option for the 2012-2013 school year. We must be on the list for the legislation to approve our designation for this schedule. It is significant in cost savings for utilities, transportation costs. Board member, Shirley Threadgill was concerned because United States students have less instructional hours that other countries, so where will that put us with that standing? Montgomery County students must still have the 1,000 hours per year. It is just when those hours will occur that can be managed. Wilkes County Schools have been doing this for several years. A copy of the letters received for the finance group are to be sent to the Montgomery County Commissioners and the County Manager.

Chairman DeBerry asked for a motion to go into closed session for the discussion of personnel. With a motion from Sandra Miller, along with a second from Tommy Blake, the board unanimously approved the adjournment to closed session.

Upon returning from closed session, Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to adjourn. With a motion from Shirley Threadgill, along with a second from Tommy Blake, the meeting was duly adjourned.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, June 6, 2011.
