GOBBLE GOBBLE ~ TURKEY ACTIVITY FUN IN PHYSICAL THERAPY WITH DR. BERNADETTE M. RACIOPPI NOVEMBER

SUPPLIES NEEDED: COLANDER/STRAINER, FEATHERS (OR LEAVES WITH STEMS) TURKEY PICTURE OPTIONAL WORKS ON: COLOR RECOGNITION, FINE MOTOR, GROSS MOTOR, PROBLEM SOLVING, FOLLOWING DIRECTIONS

<u>GAME OBJECT:</u> Need something to do during the holiday week? This fun game can be played with one or more children. Ask your child to retrieve a color out of a pile of feathers. Have them use both hands to place the feather into a strainer. This one was a dollar store purchase, but I made the holes slightly bigger so that the feather stem would fit through.

If your child is able, try naming 2 colors at the same time. This is a higher challenge by trying to remember what two colors were named. Able to accomplish this? Try requesting 3 colors!

Your directions would be:

'I need you to find red.'

'I need you to find blue and purple.'

'I need you to find pink, yellow and green'.

TO CHALLENGE BALANCE AND ADD IN GROSS MOTOR OPPORTUNITY:

Place feathers on the floor in random places and varied heights. (floor, under and on top of pillows, chair, table top)

Encourage your child to retrieve the feathers by squatting to the floor, or bending to peek under pillows or standing tippy toes to reach one off of a table or the sofa. Do whatever is safest for your child's ability.

Keep the strainer on the floor so that they have to squat to place the feather into the holes. Cue them with 'bend your knees' so that they are bending properly and using their muscles. Have them use their helper hand to assist holding the strainer so that it doesn't wiggle as they are putting the feathers in.

Whatever level you chose to do have a fun time and enjoy the Thanksgiving break!

Please send in your PreK Student's proof of flu vaccination record

Dear Parent/Guardian of PreK Student

According to N.J.A.C. 8:57-4 Immunization of Pupils in School, students in preschool must provide the district with proof of vaccinations in order to attend school. Students are also required to have a physical on file.

Documentation must be received by **December 20, 2024**. <u>Failure to provide proof of the flu vaccination will result in your child being excluded from our program and he/she will not be permitted to</u>



<u>return to class in January.</u> If excluded, your child's spot may be given up to another student who has been waiting to register.
