## July 11, 2011

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, July 11, 2011, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

The agenda continued to the 2010-2011 State Accountability Testing Report. Overall the district is up. We are addressing the reading inconsistencies. Apex Learning is working with us for an extra 3 months which gives students an opportunity to accelerate or catch up areas they need. Montgomery County Library is helping sponsor this and we provide transportation. We are bringing back sustained silent reading and being more systematic in all Montgomery County schools. More information will be forthcoming in the August 1, 2011 Montgomery County Board of Education meeting.

Montgomery County schools had 85 teachers come together to discuss strategy. This was the time for our teachers to shape what we will do. Among areas of discussion is curriculum alignment. Common core is national curriculum that will be starting next year, but we will put some things in place now. Teachers seem happy to establish guidelines. There were great discussions about detailed instruction guides for different classes, better benchmarks and getting data before the end of the year which helps students and teachers to know what the student needs. This is an exciting time for teachers and students with everyone on board.

Superintendent Ellis, along with Kevin Lancaster discussed the changes that were needed to the school calendar to follow what had been passed by legislature to add 5 days to the school calendar. For this year only schools can choose to increase the school time each day as an alternative to extending 5 days since it is late in the planning and most schools have their calendar in place. A waiver must go into the North Carolina State Superintendent for this request. With a motion to approve from Ann Long, and a second from Sandra Miller, the board unanimously approved this waiver for 2011-2012 school year.

Superintendent Ellis's topic for his superintendent's remarks is the budget. We will keep everyone informed about information coming in. We will use some federal dollars that were saved and some are coming from the fund balance. There will be lots of transfers and consolidating duties. This should be in place by the end of July. Every vacancy will be looked at carefully previous to filling. While this year will be covered, next year will be a very tough time. Hopefully there will be significant increase in revenues.

Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to go into closed session for the discussion of personnel and property. With a motion from Sandra Miller, along with a second from Ann Long, the board unanimously approved the adjournment to closed session.

Upon reconvening, Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to adjourn. With a motion from Tommy Blake, along with a second from Shirley Threadgill, the meeting was duly adjourned.

The next regular meeting will be held on Monday, August 1, 2011.
