

CCMS HOOPS TEAMS KEEP ROLLING WITH DOUBLEHEADER SWEEP OF TRENTON ROSENWALD

Crockett County Middle School boys basketball coach Tyler Gadlen said it was “probably the best we’ve played all year on both ends.”

The result was a 49-39 victory over Trenton Rosenwald Thursday night, extending the Cavaliers’ winning streak to four games. That came right after the CCMS girls posted their seventh consecutive triumph with a decisive 44-13 romp over the Lady Bears.

Gadlen’s club placed three scorers in double figures in the same game for the first time all season as Jeremiah Young netted 16 and Cole Summar and Will Dodds produced 11 apiece. Summar connected on three three-pointers for the winners, who made seven of them in the contest to offset a 20-point performance by Trenton’s Max Hammonds.

Crockett cruised to a 30-13 halftime advantage, but Trenton made a game of it with a 15-8 run in the third period. Young and Brody Haley hit three-pointers in the fourth quarter to help the Cavs seal the win, boosting their season record to 8-4.

In the girls game – which was never close – Coach Jamar Turner’s Lady Cavs used a nine-point opening quarter by Haley Leforgee to jump to a 19-0 advantage. Leforgee, in the starting lineup because of Lola Bailey’s absence due to illness, made four of the game’s first five field goals, including a three-pointer.

The Lady Cav margin ballooned to 29-5 by halftime as Turner substituted liberally throughout the final three periods. Jentry Maddox netted 10 points to spark the Crockett offense overall, with Leforgee scoring nine, Khylee Cobb six, and Lillian Ray four. The seventh straight win put Crockett at 9-3 for the year.

Both CCMS teams are next in action on Monday, December 2 in a home doubleheader with Milan.
