#### MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION

#### MINUTES

# June 3, 2013

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 3, 2013, at 6:30 p.m. Board members were present as follows:

Steven W. DeBerry, Chair Tommy Blake, Vice Chair Bryan Dozier Jesse Hill Ann Long Sandra Miller Shirley Threadgill

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and moved to adopt the agenda as shown asking for the consent agenda to be held until closed session. With a motion from Ann Long, and a second from Jesse Hill, the agenda and change was adopted with unanimous approval from the board.

Opening remarks by Chairman DeBerry were from a speech by Theodore Roosevelt entitled "Citizenship in a Republic". The speech was given in Paris, France in 1910 while Mr. Roosevelt was President of the United States. A passage from the speech known as, "The Man in the Arena" is highly quoted: "It is not the critic who counts; not the man who points out how the strong man stumbles, or where the doer of deeds could have done them better. The credit belongs to the man who is actually in the arena, whose face is marred by dust and sweat and blood; who strives valiantly; who errs, who comes short again and again, because there is no error without shortcoming...". The words emphasized his belief that the success of a republic rested not on the brilliance of its citizens but on disciplined work and character; the quality of the people.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America was led by Page Street Elementary students and sisters, Kerstin and Kendall Davenport.

With no one signing up to address the board, the meeting proceeded to the recognitions.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** be it resolved that the Montgomery County Board of Education goes on record in expressing a sense of real loss and regret in her passing; that a copy of this resolution be conveyed to her family as an indication of our deep sympathy; and that a copy of the same be filed as a part of the permanent minutes of the board of education.

Montgomery County Schools AIG Plan was presented by Deidra Steed. The local AIG Plan is based on the NC AIG Program Standards. These Standards serve as a statewide framework and guide LEA's to develop, coordinate and implement thoughtful and comprehensive AIG programs. The Standards encompass six principle standards with accompanying practices. These standards describe what an LEA should have in place and guide LEA's to improve their programs. Ms. Steed explained that each student will be identified through a screening process, along with a review of EOG scores, the behavior scale, placement charts, an aptitude test and grading scale. In the fall, all fourth grade students will be screened with the COGAT test to see if they qualify for AIG. Teachers will monitor the data and pass it on to the AIG board. Teachers will be offered AIG licensure and endorsement training, as well as internet instruction. Sandra Miller made the motion to approve the plan with Bryan Dozier seconding. The motion passed unanimously.

Superintendent Ellis discussed the Balanced Scorecard for the district that shows our data responsive to our Strategic Plan with an upward climb in percentages. Definite progress is being made toward our goals. Scores from EOG tests won't be available until October, but as

soon as the information is available it will be updated and posted in the Board and Conference Room so it is visible to leadership at all times.

Next on the agenda, Child Nutrition Director Terry Jordan presented a power point on School Breakfast and Lunch Prices for the upcoming 2013-2014 school year. Due to Section 205 of the 2010 Child Nutrition Reauthorization Act, sufficient funds must be provided to the food service account for paid lunches. Therefore, school lunch prices for paying students will increase slightly effective July 1, 2013. The recommendation is to increase elementary school lunches from \$1.85 to \$1.90 per day and middle and high school students from \$1.90 to \$2.20. Breakfast will remain free for all students. After hearing the presentation, Sandra Miller approved the motion, while Tommy Blake seconded. The motion passed 7 to 0.

Beth Walker, President of First Health Montgomery, shared an update on the First Health Foundation. The foundation held a Kentucky Derby themed fundraiser on May 4<sup>th</sup>. She stated the main reason for the foundation's success was its board members. Tricia Webb, First Health Montgomery board member, announced that \$51,000 was raised to support school health centers and to reduce childhood obesity problems within the county. Many thanks to First Health Montgomery and the First Health Foundation for all their support!

Confirming a date for the End of the Year Retreat for the board was addressed by Superintendent Ellis. Tuesday, August 20<sup>th</sup> was agreed upon with a motion by Sandra Miller and a second by Ann Long. The motion passed unanimously.
