Bear Family,

I hope this letter finds you well. As we continue to progress through the school year, I would like to inform you about an important upcoming event for our 11th-grade students. This spring, all juniors will be taking the New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA).

About the NJGPA

The NJGPA is a state-mandated assessment that evaluates proficiency in both Mathematics and English Language Arts (ELA). Demonstrating proficiency in these areas is a graduation requirement set by the New Jersey Department of Education. More information on the NJGPA can be found here.

Testing Schedule:

This year, the NJGPA testing window (picked by the NJDOE) is scheduled for the week of March 10th to March 14th. Recognizing the importance of providing an optimal testing environment, we have made adjustments to our school schedule:

- Single-Session Days on March 11th and 12th: The high school will operate on a single-session schedule on these dates. This adjustment allows all students, including those requiring accommodations, to complete the Math assessment on one day and the ELA assessment on the next.
- Benefits of the Adjusted Schedule: Administering the assessments over two consecutive single-session days will help students remain focused and perform at their best. It minimizes disruptions and prevents the testing process from stretching over four consecutive days (there are a total of 4 units. Based on the bell schedule of a traditional day, we would only be able to complete 1 unit a day) which can be challenging when combined with regular afternoon classes of a traditional school day.

What This Means for Your Child:

- March 11th (Tuesday): ELA Assessment
- March 12th (Wednesday): Math Assessment
- Students will be dismissed at 12:32 on both days. Late buses will be available at 1:45 if needed.
- NJGPA Make-up window is the week of March 17th for anyone that misses a testing day.

We understand that schedule changes can be inconvenient, but we believe these adjustments will provide the best testing environment for our students. Your support is greatly appreciated.
