Dear Wildcat Parents and Guardians,

In preparation for the upcoming winter season, we want to provide you with information should we need to enact an e-learning day due to inclement weather. According to the Illinois State Board of Education, a maximum of five e-learning days may be used in place of emergency days to address inclement weather, heating, power, or water issues, public health needs, or safety.

If in-person learning is not possible, the Superintendent may announce an e-learning day. This announcement will occur by 10:00 p.m. the night prior to the e-learning day. However, if unforeseeable weather and/or circumstances occur after 10:00 p.m. then, communication will be shared as soon as possible, but no later than 5:00 a.m.

Students and families will be notified by text, email, and phone at the numbers and addresses listed in PowerSchool. Notices will also be posted in four additional locations: the **D94 website**, the **West Chicago Community High School Facebook**, **Emergency Closing Center**, and the **Community HS Dist 94 X/Twitter account.**

Den Teachers will review this year's **e-learning slideshow** with students.

E-learning Expectations for Students

- 1. Login to Google Classroom for each class.
- 2. Fill out the Google attendance form for each class by 1 pm.
- 3. Students do NOT login to their Den Google Classroom on an e-learning day. Attendance will NOT be posted for Den.
- 4. Complete the assignments that are posted in Google Classroom.
- 5. Submit completed assignments in Google Classroom.

Teachers are available via email throughout the day. Faculty email addresses are available in the **staff directory**. Students can email their teacher(s) with questions; however, students should work on other assignments until they receive a reply. Tech help is available at **elearning@d94.org** for Chromebook issues. Students may check out a hotspot in the LRC before an e-learning day to ensure they have internet access.
