

**MONTGOMERY COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION
MINUTES**

June 5, 2017

The Montgomery County Board of Education convened in its regular monthly meeting on Monday, June 5, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. Board members present were Steven W. DeBerry – Chair, Tommy Blake – Vice Chair, Jesse Hill, Ann Long, Shirley Threadgill, Sandra Miller and Bryan Dozier.

Chairman DeBerry called the meeting to order and moved to adopt the agenda as shown. Sandra Miler made the motion with Tommy Blake seconding. The agenda was accepted with unanimous approval from the board.

Chairman DeBerry opened by reading Luke 6:38: Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

Chairman DeBerry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

During the public comment period, community member Sherri Allgood and student Keyshawn Steele addressed the board. Speakers were given three minutes to voice their concerns.

A Resolution of Esteem for Angie Medjrich Tofflemeyer was presented to her family. Mrs. Tofflemeyer served as a teacher, assistant principal and principal with Montgomery County Schools. Chairman DeBerry read the resolution as follows:

Superintendent Ellis and Deputy Superintendent Lancaster recognized the Montgomery County Schools Employees of the Year. Employees received a certificate of their accomplishment. Recognized were Bus Driver of the Year – Debbie Allen, Candor Elementary; Bus Driver of the Year – Donna Brown, West Montgomery; Child Nutrition Employee of the Year – Brenda Shuping, Green Ridge Elementary; Instructional Support Employee of the Year – Anita Mashburn, Green Ridge; Teacher Assistant of the Year – Adrena Little, East Middle; Custodian of the Year – Walter Pegues, Page Street Elementary; Office Support of the Year – Clara Armstrong, West Middle; Auxiliary Services Employee of the Year – Jamie Smith, Transportation.

Mitch Taylor and Superintendent Ellis reported on the Capital Outlay Fund Budget Resolution for the East Middle Wing. The resolution states how money will be moved to pay for the wing. The county will reimburse funds that we spend quarterly for three years beginning spring of 2018. Tommy Blake made the motion to approve the resolution with Jesse Hill seconding. The board approved the motion unanimously.

Dr. Lancaster then presented the following policy codes for approval. These codes were presented for first reading at the May board meeting. Sandra Miller made the motion to approve the policy changes with Ann Long seconding. The board approved unanimously.

In his Superintendent Remarks, Dr. Ellis commented on the shirts he, Dr. Lancaster and Dr. James were wearing. The shirts have Montgomery Central Timberwolves with a generic logo on them. He stated that although this was not the official logo, they wanted to get the name out in the community. He also stated that the central high school project was moving well and the site bid package would be going out the end of July. A design package has been submitted to the USDA that formalizes the floor plan and lays out what the CTE building should look like. At the July board meeting, the goal is to bring to the board specific elevations to show what the high school will look like inside and outside. Exciting things are happening to benefit the students of Montgomery County Schools.

Chairman DeBerry then asked for a motion to go into closed session to discuss personnel. Ann Long asked for the motion, with Sandra Miller seconding. The board approved the motion unanimously.
