MCVTS OUTSTANDING ACTIVITIES – HIGHLIGHTS

The Superintendent is reporting highlights of recent districtwide school/student activities that have occurred since the last Board of Education meeting. These activities involve career, college, community, and business collaboration with various partners to enhance the students' educational programs.

Academy of Allied Health & Biomedical Sciences

- The Junior Class hosted the Annual Fall Dance, A Night in the City, which was a huge success. Approximately 150 students attended, the largest turnout in many years. The gym featured backgrounds against which students took pictures, a student served as the DJ and master of ceremonies, and there was food, soft drinks and desserts.
- Interact Club held its annual Thanksgiving food drive. This year, over 2,000 pounds of food were collected for the Woodbridge-based St. James Parish Food Bank.
- We successfully completed the new process of fall registration for AP exams and Rutgers exams by using Total Registration and RegiSmart. Congratulations for implementing the systems go out to Ms. Lisa Ferrier and Ms. Katie Elko, guidance counselors. In all, 390 Rutgers University School of Health Professions exams will be administered. For AP Exams, 227 students registered for 399 exams.



Piscataway Partial Roofing Replacement - SSP/Owner – JDS Roofing- Change order work, wall panel install ongoing. Punch list issued for original project, ongoing.

Piscataway Lot Reconstruction Phase II/SSP/Edwards/Owner-Paving Materials & Contracting, LLC. – Change order CO-02 as a credit to owner in the sum of \$18,275.00 for unused allowance in this contract. Project remains in closeout at this time.

East Brunswick Music Room/SSP/Owner-Santori Construction, Inc. – Progress payment No.4 in the sum of \$352,325.43 adjendized for consideration. Rough electrical, framing inspections complete and passed. Contractor installing specialty wall boards, heating, ductwork at this time.

East Brunswick/CD/Kitchen Exhaust Partial Replacement/SSP/Owner Chappelle Mechanical – Progress payment No. 3 in the sum of \$49,732.50 and payment No. 4 in the sum of \$9,072.52 or agendized for payment. Final inspections and start up scheduled for December 19th through 23rd 2019.

Water Heater Replacement(s), P.A., K, E.B., SSP/Owner – Alternate project scope continues to be developed for evaluation at this time.

Other District Projects

ESIP - Johnson Controls International SSP/Owner – Payment application No. 31 in the sum of \$20,006.00 advanced for payment. Particulate separator installed, inspections, balancing and testing remain as open items on Heat Pump replacement portion of this project.

ESIP Phase II- Honeywell International, SSP/Owner –Project meeting took place on November 27, 2019 to finalize action items remaining for project to go to design. The design team will complete a final survey next week in hope of advancing the project to bid in late December.

Annual Report

Integrated Pest Management – As part of the reporting standard of the I.P.M. program, adopted on June 12, 2004, Policy File Code 7422 I am reporting that the School Policy and Program have been effective from both the notification and control standpoints. The program requirement is met by inclusion in the policy edition distributed to all students and staff.

Notifications of application for prior year are sent out as letters to students and staff outlining application chemicals, E.P.A. registration numbers and date(s) of application individually, by campus. Building and central office logbooks are maintained which generate information for control and notification requirements.

The mandate of the Program requires District level oversight, with a specific building component which must be addressed at that level. Further evaluation of the building level weekly reporting requirement, implemented in last year's report, is still sporadic at best. At this time, no major augmentation to the Policy is being recommended to the Board other than having Principal(s) and Assistant Principal(s) take the mandated certification course and apply standards to their individual school buildings, increase weekly surveillance and reporting. This satisfies the reporting element of the Program, by the I.P.M. Coordinator, Mr. Francis P. Cap, dated December 11, 2019.

Indoor Air Quality – As part of the reporting standard of the mandated I.A.Q. Program, adopted on January 14, 2009, amended on December 14, 2011, Policy File Code 7421, I am reporting that the standards set forth in the act are being met with the use of both District and Professional Services as needed on a proactive (notification and evaluation) as well as active (complaint based) action or actions. As the standard serves both the established compliance guidelines as well as subjective interpretation, continued monitoring, reporting and occupant education are to remain as ongoing.
