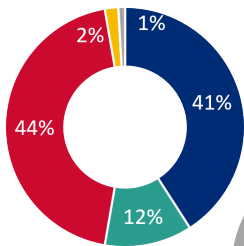
PROFESSIONAL STAFF: In the 2024-2025 school year, there are 110 full-time faculty members, including 45 U.S. citizens, 13 from other English-speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada and Ireland, and 49 host-country nationals. The remaining are from other nationalities including Brazil and Romania. All teachers are either bilingual or native English speakers.

DESCRIPTION: Founded in 1956, the **Carlucci American International School of Lisbon** (CAISL) is a non-profit, non-denominational college preparatory day school that serves students from Early Childhood (age 3) through Grade 12 (age 18). CAISL offers a high-quality American-style education, balancing academic excellence with a strong emphasis on athletics, arts, and personal growth. Students are challenged to reach their full potential in a caring and supportive environment.

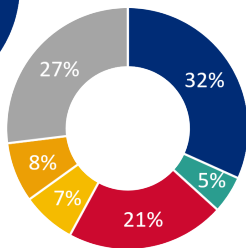
As part of a diverse international community, CAISL promotes active citizenship in a rapidly changing world and prepares students for global university admissions. The school offers Portuguese language and culture programs, as well as an intensive English as an Additional Language (EAL) program for non-fluent English speakers. English is the primary language of instruction.

Additionally, CAISL provides a comprehensive co-curricular program designed to complement our academic excellence. Students engage in a wide range of activities, from competitive athletics and academic teams like Model United Nations (MUN) to vibrant fine and performing arts. With numerous student-led organizations, we encourage leadership, creativity, and collaboration, ensuring a holistic educational experience that prepares students for success in all areas of life.

ENROLLMENT: In September 2024, enrollment was 739 (EC3 through grade 5: 312; grades 6 through 12: 427). Of the total, 235 were U.S. citizens, 157 were host-country nationals, and 347 were third-country nationals including 37 from English-speaking countries such as the U.K., Canada, and South Africa. Of the U.S. enrollment, 74 were dependents of U.S. government direct-hire or contract employees, and 161 were other private U.S. citizens.

RECOGNITION: CAISL is accredited by the Middle States Association (MSA), and is licensed by the Portuguese Ministry of Education (ME). CAISL is an authorized International Baccalaureate (IB) World School and offers the IB Diploma Program for the last two years of High School. CAISL is the only school in Portugal with sponsorship from the U.S. Department of State.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENT: To graduate, students must earn a minimum of 27 academic credits during Grades 9-12 (1 credit represents a full-year course). The credit requirements are as follows: 4 credits in English, 3 credits in Mathematics, 3 credits in Science, 3 credits in Social Studies, 2 credits in a Foreign Language, 3 credits in Physical Education, 1 credit in Computer Science, 1 credit in Fine Arts, and 7 credits in Electives.

GRADING: The High School uses the letter grades A+ to F. The minimum passing grade is D (60%). CAISL reports incidents of academic malpractice, suspensions or exclusions which occur in the student's last three semesters of attendance. Grade point average applies only to courses taken at CAISL, and the school does not produce student rankings.

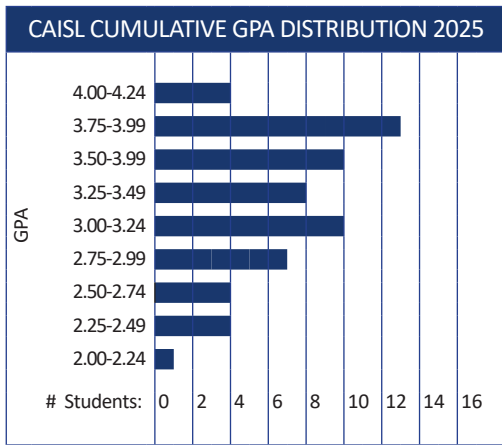

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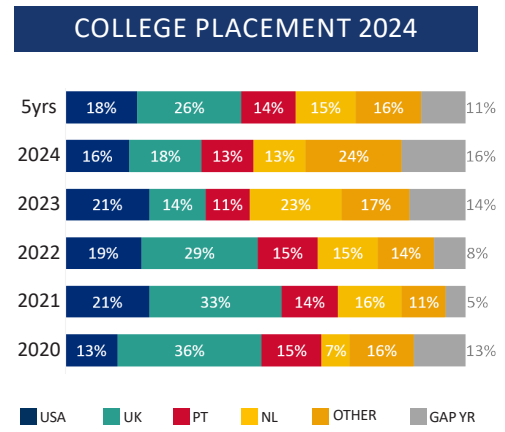
