From the School Counseling Department: Attention Senior Parents and Guardians - the FAFSA has been released!

Great news - the FAFSA has been released ahead of schedule! It is now available for students and parents/guardians to complete. Remember, the sooner families fill it out the greater chance the student has for more aid. Follow the steps below to complete the FAFSA; please do not hesitate to reach out to the School Counseling Department with any questions!

1. Both the student and a minimum of one parent or guardian needs to create an FSA ID prior to starting the FAFSA. Students had the opportunity to create their FSA IDs at school this past Tuesday. Use the following handout to guide you through the process: [FSA-ID-How-to-Guide.pdf](#)
