Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Southern Fulton High School

Our water system violated several drinking water standards over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During 2024 we failed to monitor for the following contaminants and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the contaminant we did not properly test for during the last year, the required sampling frequency, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which corrective action samples were taken.

What happened? What was done? When will it be resolved?

PFAS samples were collected by Negley's Water and sent to the subcontracted lab to be analyzed, when in transport the containers were damaged and the samples were invalidated. By the time we were notified to re-collect the sample the 2nd quarter had ended. The samples were recollected during the 3rd quarter and show there is no PFAS detected in the water.

Please share this information with all the other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (for example, people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
