## Grade 3: Weekly Phonics Focus Lesson 22

In our classroom this week, we will review how to read and spell words with the **vowel-r syllable pattern**. Here is the pattern to practice this week:

Vowel-r	Vowel-r syllables have 1 vowel sound spelled with 1 or 2 vowels			
Syllables	and the consonant r, which affects the way the vowel sound is			
	pronounced. The consonant w before the vowel-r pattern changes			
	the a-r and o-r vowel sounds.			

Here are some examples of words with the vowel-r syllable pattern:

c <u>ar</u>	c <u>or</u> n	<u>war</u> m	<u>wor</u> n	f <u>er</u> n	b <u>ir</u> d	s <u>ur</u> f

Below are activities to practice at home this week. You may also use the activities and questions from the initial *Family Support Letter* to further address your child's success in learning the weekly phonics focus.

## **Read Words**

Guide your child through reading vowel-r words by saying, "Let's read some words." Read these steps to your child:

- 1. Find the vowel letters and underline them. If there is a consonant *r* following the vowel remember to underline it as part of the vowel sound.
- 2. Say the syllable type and the vowel sound. Remember, the consonant *w* before the vowel-r pattern changes the a-r and o-r vowel sounds.
- 3. Read the word.

## **Word Sort**

Guide your child through this Word Sort by saying, "Let's sort vowel-r words." Read these steps to your child:

- 1. Find the vowel letter. Check if the *consonant* r follows the vowel.
- 2. Say the vowel sound. Remember, the consonant *w* before the vowel-r pattern changes the a-r and o-r vowel sounds.
- 3. Write the word under the correct column and read the word.
- 4. When all the words are written in the chart, read them all.
