Type of Scholarship

A one year scholarship to be paid to the bursar of the university in the recipient's name upon presentation of the award letter to the student council advisor or treasurer.

Who May Apply

Any graduating senior from Eaton High School who is planning to continue his/her education at a college, university or technical school.

The Requirements

1. Must have applied to/have been accepted at an accredited college or university or technical school.
2. Must have been involved and has served on the High School Student Council a minimum of 2 years during the four years in high school.
3. Please write me a letter describing what *contributions, events, leadership, etc.* in which you have taken the leadership role for EHS over the years in your position as officer. See last page for details.
