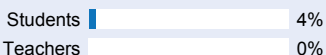

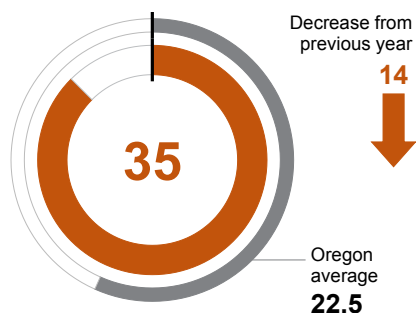

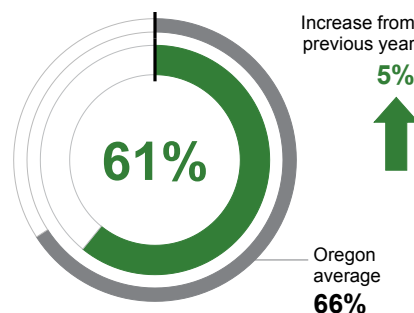
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

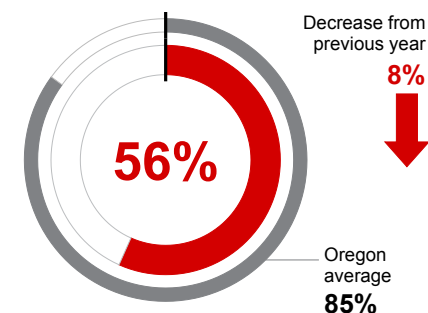
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

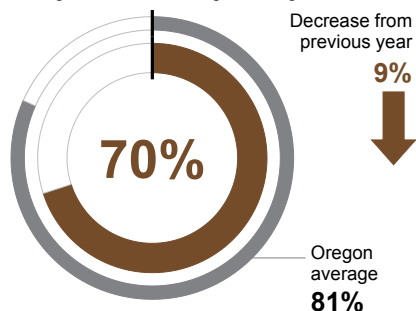
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

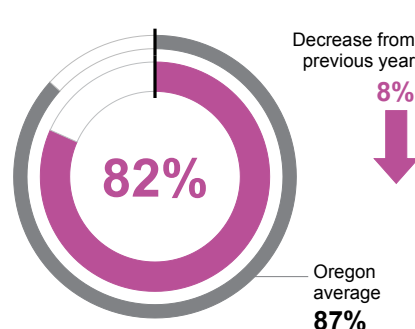
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2019-20 graduating in 2022-23.



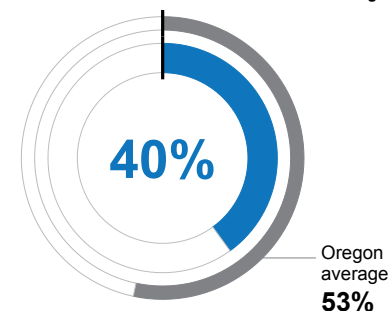
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

About Our School

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Hillsboro Online Academy offers Honors and Accelerated options in all core courses.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

Hillsboro Online Academy provides over 60 introductory Career and Technical Education (CTE) Courses to students attending HOA and to high school students attending other schools in the District (concurrent enrollment). Hillsboro Online offers Criminal Justice and Agriculture Career and College Pathway programs to high school students across the District. Our students can also enroll in specialized CTE programs taking place at other campuses, such as Fire Science at Liberty High School.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Hillsboro Online Academy has a number of clubs such as STEM, Chess, Reading, Robotics, Engineering, Art, and Running. Students at our school can participate in OSAA athletics and activities at their neighborhood schools. Hillsboro Online is an OSAA Associate Member and the core courses at our school are NCAA-approved.

PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Hillsboro Online Academy engages stakeholders through a variety of events attended by students, their families, and members of the community. These include Back-to-School Night, in-person orientations for full-time and concurrently enrolled students, parent "How to Support Your Online Learner" sessions, Career and College Information nights, Science Fair, HOA Information Evenings, and Family Game Nights. Students access internship opportunities at local businesses through the Chamber of Commerce's School-to-Career program.
