# **Enrollment in Advanced Placement (AP) Courses on the Rise at Kingsway**

We are excited to share that participation in Advanced Placement (AP) courses at Kingsway is continuing to grow. (Kingsway's Commitment to AP Course Drives 37% Growth in Enrollment.) In the 2022-23 school year, 1,375 seats were filled in AP courses, and for the 2024-25 school year, that number has climbed to 2,183—representing a 37% increase. Registration for AP exams has also risen, from 627 in 2023-24 to 913 currently, a 16% increase.

This growth reflects Kingsway's commitment to offering opportunities for students to challenge themselves with rigorous coursework. We have also become increasingly skilled at identifying students with the potential to excel, who might not have otherwise considered enrolling in an AP course.
