#### Nurses Notes

Cold and flu season has arrived. Parents often ask, when do I keep my child home from school? Here are some guidelines for keeping sick children at home. As always, please consult your doctor with any concerns.

- When Should Children Stay Home From School/NJDOH
- Help Your Child's School Prevent the Spread of Infections/CDC
  - A child with heavy cold symptoms, such as deep or uncontrollable coughing or significant lack of energy, belongs at home even without a fever. They should return when they can comfortably participate in school activities.
  - If your child has a fever, keep them home for at least 24 hours after the fever is gone without the use of fever-reducing medicines, such as acetaminophen. This will help ensure that the fever is truly gone and that your child is past the point of being contagious.
  - If your child has pain in their ears, throat, head or chest and can not comfortably participate in school activities.
  - If your child is vomiting or has diarrhea, they must have neither for 24 hours before they can return to school.

#### Why is this important?

- Children need rest to recover from illness. Without enough rest, it can take your child longer to feel better. Staying home is also important because your child can spread the illness up to 24 hours after symptoms are gone.
- People with weakened immune systems often need even more time to recover and to stop being contagious.

### 2024-2025 Areas of Focus

While it has been a great start to the school year, we are asking for your help to continue this momentum. As previously shared, *Student Attendance*, including lates to school and/or class and our updated *Cell Phone/ Electronic Device Use Policy* continue to serve as focus areas for the 2024-2025 school year. As you can imagine, these areas of focus are directly correlated to our goals of Student Academic Success and Social-Emotional Well Being.

Chronic Absenteeism or students arriving late to school and/or their classes can be a distraction that takes away from valuable class time, not only for them, but for their entire class. Over the past couple of weeks, we have seen a drastic incline of students arriving late to school. As a reminder, doors open at 7:05 and students should be in their first period class by 7:15am. Please note... Breakfast is now being served each morning in the cafeteria. Students arriving early to school can enter through Door 13 by the tennis courts beginning at 6:35am.

Additionally, as a reminder... **Cell Phone Use** is not permitted during class time for any reason at any time. Students are permitted to utilize their cell phones and/or electronic devices during transition time or their lunch period.
