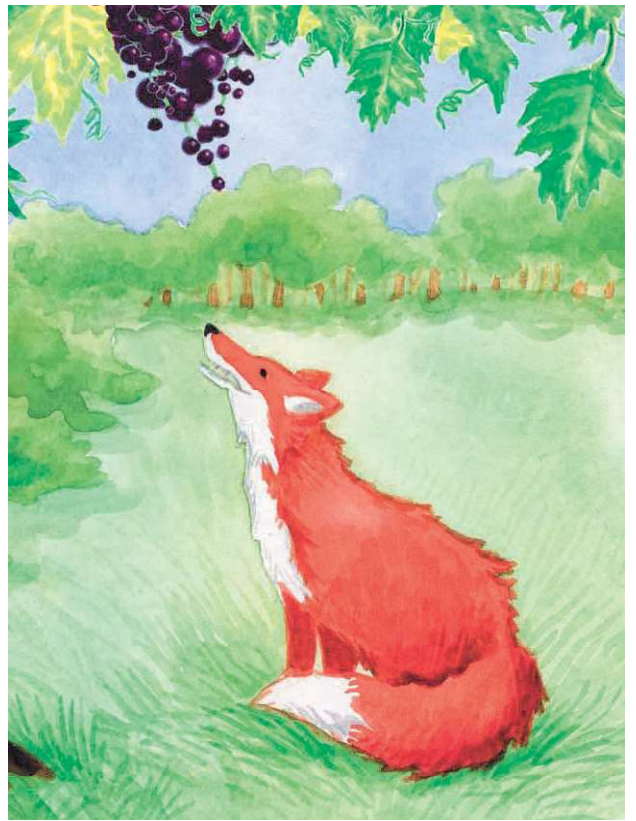


The Fox and the Grapes
