RE:

South High School Lead In Water Testing

Drinking water was tested at South High School on March 17, 2023. The testing was performed as part of our Lead in Water Safety Program and as recommended by the Minnesota Department of Health. The purpose of this program is to ensure that school drinking water does not exceed a permissible lead level of 20 parts per billion (ppb).

All water at South High School was collected on a first draw basis with a minimum of six-hour system stagnation. This method represents the worst case scenario for lead in water concentrations. A total of twenty-three (23) drinking sources were tested (see attached lab report). Nineteen (19) samples collected were non-detected for lead in drinking water. Four (4) fixtures showed low levels of lead. These fixtures have been updated with "lead free" components. Follow up testing was performed on these four fixtures on May 5, 2023 and the results were non-detected for lead in drinking water (see attached lab report).

It is good news to receive test results identifying drinking source to be below the 20-ppb standard. However, because not all piping at South High School has been replaced with new piping, potential sources of lead remain; we have determined that the safest course of action is for South High School to continue its participation in the Lead in Water Flushing Program. EH&S has communicated the procedures for proper flushing with your Senior Custodian and the importance to perform these procedures daily. As a safe practice, EH&S recommends that all fountains be run until cool before drinking.
