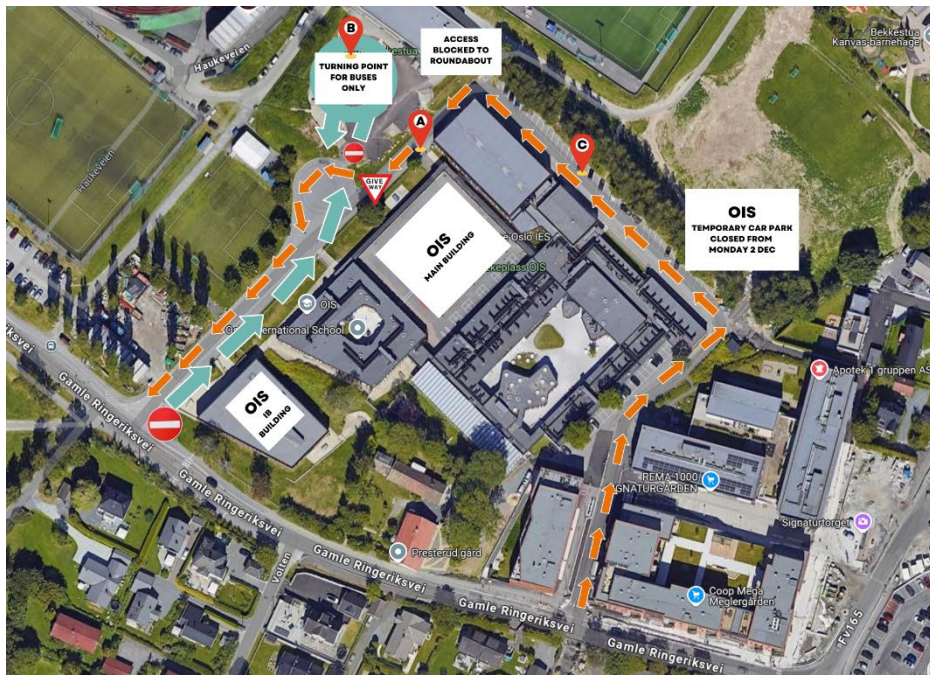
CHANGES TO TRAFFIC FLOW








Dear OIS Community,

As shared in yesterday's email, construction work around the school is progressing ahead of schedule. This means we are regaining access to key areas sooner than expected, but also necessitates the closure of some temporary parking. Following today's meeting with Bærum Kommune, we can now confirm the updated traffic system, which will come into effect tomorrow morning.

Key Changes to the Traffic System:

- **New Car Park Access:** The newly marked parking spaces behind the gymnasium will be available for use from tomorrow morning.
- **Field Car Park Closure:** The temporary parking area in the field behind the school will no longer be accessible from Monday 2 December.
- **Reinstatement of One-Way Traffic:** The road behind the school (from Coop Mega, around the gymnasium) will revert to a one-way street. Vehicles dropping off children must proceed along this road and exit via the front drive; turning or exiting back along this road will no longer be possible.
- **Morning Drop-Off Point:** The designated drop-off point for children is at the school's front gate. Please allow extra time and expect queues during peak times.
- **Front Drive Access:** The driveway in front of the school will now function as an exit route only for cars. Starting Monday, buses will have access to the road and the roundabout (for turning). Cars exiting via the front drive are reminded to give way to buses.
- **No Stopping on the Front Drive:** Stopping or parking on the driveway in front of the school is no longer permitted. This area is reserved solely for moving cars exiting the one-way system.

While these changes should improve traffic flow, we encourage families to allow extra time for their morning routines as we all adjust to the updated system.
