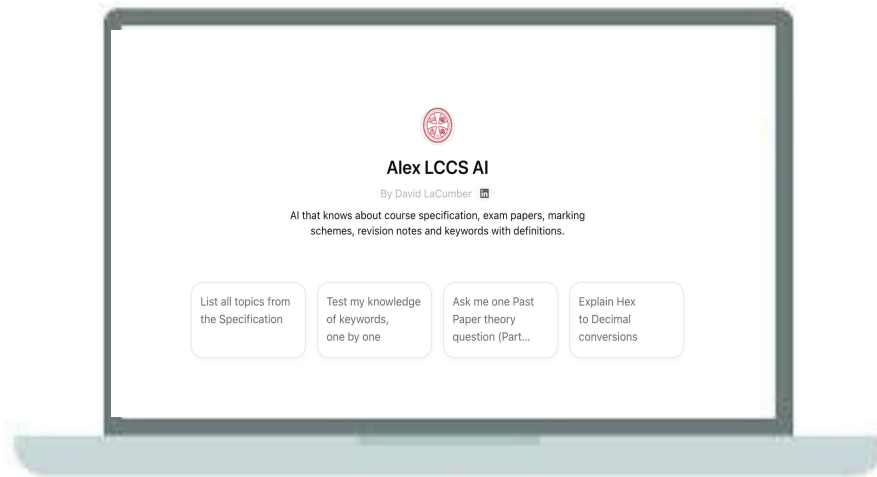

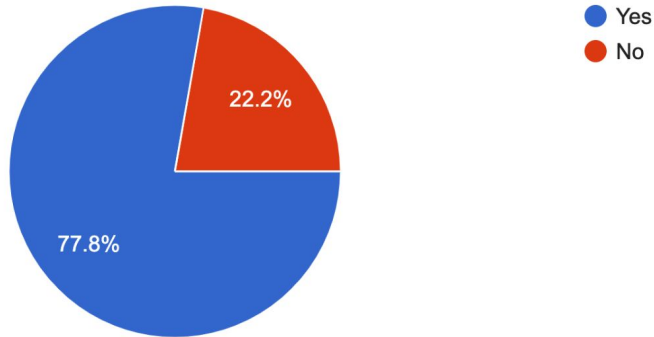


# Leaving Cert Student Survey

45 responses

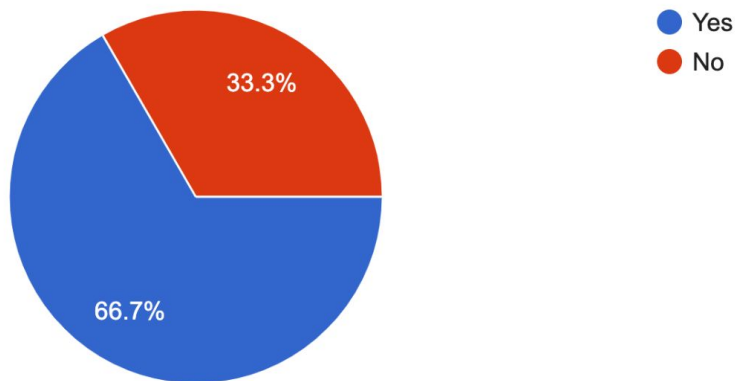


Average Annual Spend on apps/subscriptions: €100

# Leaving Cert Student Survey - Considerations

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Many Alex parents can afford to pay for extra app subscriptions and grinds, but not all can. **Could we do anything in-house to tackle this issue?**

# Leaving Cert Student Survey - Considerations

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Both staff and students would need a ChatGPT account - €20 per month.

AlexAI could offer students:

- exam papers with mark schemes (StudyClix)
- keywords with definitions (QuizLet)
- Analyse uploaded homework (from camera)
- Summarises of teacher notes

Interested teachers would need to invest time to train their AI, providing tailored documentation and experimenting with the AI to find the best fit for their subject.
