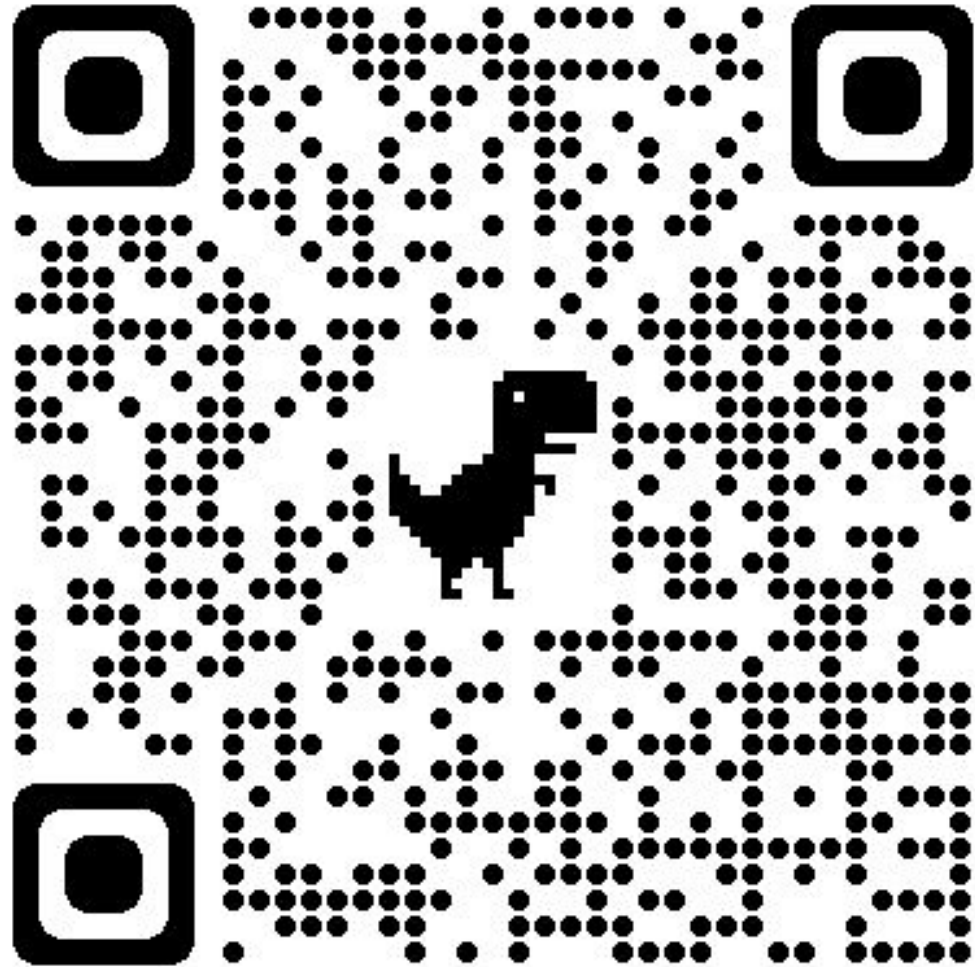

English	4 credits	
Math	4 credits

Social Studies	3 credits	
Fine Arts	1 credit	
Health	.5 credit	
Physical Education	.5 credit or PE Waiver	
Personal Finance/Capstone	.5 credit	
General Electives	4.5 (no PE Waiver) or 5 (PE Waiver)	

## *Part 2: Demonstrating Competency*

Competency scores (684 or higher) on English II and Algebra I OST exams

- Must be retaken if not passed)

Alternative Demonstrations of Competency (per ODE):

- College Credit Plus
- ACT or SAT
