<p><b>Transcript:</b> student requests via SchoolLinks; school sends with Counselor docs (see below) via SchoolLinks.</p>	<p><b>Application and Essay:</b> Common App or school specific App. Student Submits Via common app</p> <p><b>Test Scores:</b> student requests a score send directly to colleges via ACT and SAT websites.</p>
<p><b>Counselor Recommendation Letter or Secondary School Report Form:</b> Student must book 30 min. Meeting with counselor for completion of forms and recommendation letter. Sent via SchoolLinks.</p>	<p><b>Teacher Recommendation Letter:</b> Student requests via SchoolLinks. Teacher sends via SchoolLinks.</p>

## DEFINITIONS OF ADMISSION OPTIONS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

### STUDENTS: WHICH COLLEGE ADMISSION PROCESS BEST SUITS YOU?

Regular Decision	Rolling Admission	Early Action (EA)	Early Decision (ED)	Restrictive Early Action (REA)
<b>DEFINITION:</b> Students submit an application by a specified date and receive a decision in a clearly stated period of time.	<b>DEFINITION:</b> Institutions review applications as they are submitted and render admission decisions throughout the admission cycle.	<b>DEFINITION:</b> Students apply early and receive a decision well in advance of the institution's regular response date.	<b>DEFINITION:</b> Students make a commitment to a first-choice institution where, if admitted they definitely will enroll and withdraw all other applications. The application deadline and decision deadline occur early.	<b>DEFINITION:</b> Students apply to an institution of preference and receive a decision early. They may be restricted from applying ED or EA or REA to other institutions if offered enrollment, they have until May 1 to confirm.
<b>COMMITMENT:</b> NON-BINDING	<b>COMMITMENT:</b> NON-BINDING	<b>COMMITMENT:</b> NON-BINDING	<b>COMMITMENT:</b> BINDING	<b>COMMITMENT:</b> NON-BINDING

Students are not restricted from applying to other institutions and have until May 1 to consider their options and confirm enrollment.

Students are responsible for determining and following restrictions.
