## MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION CHILD FIND

Are you concerned about the speech, development, learning, or behavior of a child?



**Child Find** is an effort by the Oxford School District to locate, identify, and evaluate children with disabilities who may need early intervention. From birth to 21 years of age.

Anyone concerned about a child's speech, learning, behavior, or development can make a **Child Find** request.

A multidisciplinary evaluation will involve a series of observations conducted by two or more specialists with the child and caregivers.

## Who should I contact?

For birth to 2 years of age, contact the local Health Department. For a child 3 years of age to 21 years of age, contact Oxford School District.

## What should I bring to determine if a multidisciplinary evaluation is necessary?

Although you are not required to bring anything with you, any records you have can assist in describing your concerns about a child.



Identify. Locate. Evaluate.
