ACT/SAT INFORMATION

All 11th grade students (third year of high school) and all 12th grade students (4th year of high school) are being offered the opportunity to take the ACT or the SAT School Day exam at North Myrtle Beach High School during the regular school week this Spring.

The ACT and SAT are 4-year college entrance exams and are designed for students who plan to attend a 4-year college right after high school. The ACT (Digital) will be administered on Wednesday, February 26, 2025. The SAT (Digital) will be administered on Wednesday, March 12, 2025. Depending on your students' plans after high school, they may NOT need to take either of these tests. Students who plan to attend a 2-year college, join the military, or enter the workforce after high school DO NOT need to take the ACT or the SAT.
