### District 11 Committee Vision

Our vision is a thriving school district where internal and community committees are collaborative engines for achieving goals in District 11 set by the BOE and Superintendent.

### District Accountability Committee, District Accountability Budget Subcommittee, District Accountability Accreditation Subcommittee

\*Signifies State Requirement of DAC/SAC

1. Publicize opportunities to serve and solicit parents to serve on the DAC \*
2. Assist the district in implementing the district’s parent engagement policy\* and supporting the District’s efforts on Family, School, and Community Partnerships
3. Assist school personnel to increase parents’ engagement with educators, including parents’ engagement in creating students’ READ plans, Individual Career and Academic Plans, and plans to address habitual truancy\*
4. The DAC and SACs delegate the responsibility of evaluating student academic growth as it relates to teacher and principal evaluations to the District Personnel Performance Evaluation Advisory Council (PAC) \*
  - a. In alignment with District Personnel Performance Evaluation Advisory Council (PAC) membership requirements, one or two DAC representatives will serve on the PAC and report back to the DAC.
5. Provide input to the school board concerning the creation and enforcement of its school conduct and discipline code\*
  - a. Review the recently updated student conduct code and provide feedback on Attendance, Behavior, and Cell Phone (ABC) policy updates.
6. Review new to D11 Charter School applications.\*
7. At least quarterly, discuss whether School District leadership, personnel, and infrastructure are advancing or impeding the implementation of the UDIP (or other progress pertinent to the school district’s accreditation contract)\*
8. Provide training and assistance to schools and School Accountability Committees (SACs)
  - a. On roles and responsibilities such as Unified School Improvement Plan (USIP) requirements, School Performance Frameworks (SPF), and school accreditation requirements.
  - b. Support the creation of SACs in schools to ensure fulfillment of state requirements.
  - c. Develop and disseminate a DAC newsletter focused on DAC activity and SAC planning guidance.
9. Provide annual feedback on initiatives such as:
  - a. Academic Master Plan & Academic Support Plan implementation
  - b. 2024 enrollment strategy
  - c. Other initiatives as determined by the Board of Education
10. Ensure that full DAC and DAC subcommittee work is aligned, coherent, and not duplicative.
  - a. In as much as it is possible, strive for one presentation per topic, review by the subcommittees and full committee as needed.

### DAC Budget Sub-Committee Charges

\*Signifies State Requirement of DAC/SAC

1. Recommend to the school board via the full DAC priorities for spending school district moneys.\*
  - a. Provide feedback and additional recommendations on budget priorities set by the BOE.

### DAC Accreditation Sub-committee Charges

\*Signifies State Requirement of DAC/SAC

1. Submit recommendations through the full DAC to the school board concerning the preparation of the district’s Unified Improvement Plan.
2. Support SACs to meet state and federal requirements:
  - a. Make recommendations to the principal of the school and the superintendent concerning the
