The purpose of the financial aid program at Cape Fear Academy is to provide greater access to students who would not otherwise be able to enroll due to financial constraints. Step 1: Login/Create a New Account. “Login” if you are an existing FACTS user or “Create a New Account” if you are applying for financial aid for the first time using FACTS.

Step 2: Follow the prompts to “Create an Account”. Be sure to write down your login information so you can return to the application at a later time.

Step 3: Complete the financial aid application. You may find the following information useful in the completion of the financial aid application:

- 2024 wage statements (W2 or 1099) and 2023 federal tax returns (Form 1040 and accompanying schedules)
- Business tax returns and schedules for self-employed applicants
- Bank statements, retirement accounts, stocks/bonds and home value/ property accounts
- Medical and/or parent educational debt
- Dependent and/or elder care expenses
- Alimony and/or child support, social security benefits and any other nontaxable income

Step 4: Pay the non-refundable \$45 application fee. The application will not be “submitted” until the fee is paid. There are no fee waivers.

Step 5: Submit all required supporting documents. Please upload the following documents in support of your application:

- 2024 wage statements (W2 or 1099)
- 2023 federal tax returns (Form 1040 and accompanying schedules)
- Copies of all supporting tax documents if you have business income/loss from any of the following:
 - Business - send Schedule C or C-EZ and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Farm - send Schedule F and Form 4562 Depreciation and Amortization
 - Rental Property - send Schedule E (page 1)

- S-Corporation - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1120S, Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
- Partnership - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1065, Schedule K-1 and Form 8825
- Estates and Trusts - send Schedule E (page 2), Form 1041 and Schedule K-1
- Copies of all supporting documentation for household nontaxable income such as: Social Security, Alimony, Child Support, Workers' Compensation, Welfare, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

If you do not file a tax return, you are required to provide documentation of all income received.
