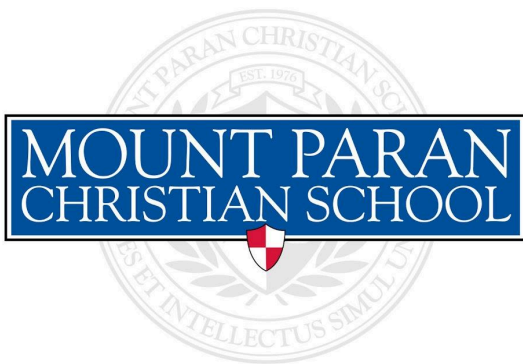
Note: The Zone after-school care program payment plan will be the same as the selected student tuition payment plan.

Full Payment — Due on or before June 30, 2025.

3 Payments*— First payment due on or before June 30, 2025. Second payment due on or before October 31, 2025, Third payment due on or before February 28, 2026.

10 Payments*— First payment due on or before June 30, 2025. Subsequent payments will be due monthly July 1, 2025 - April 30, 2026. No scheduled payment will be due in December 2025.

- If an account falls thirty (30) days past due, the parents and/or guarantors will be contacted, and the student will not be allowed to attend The Zone until the tuition is paid to an up-to-date status. The account will be subject to appropriate penalties including all late fees.
- Withdrawal from extended-day programs during the year will require proration of yearly fees.
- All other terms and conditions stated on the Tuition Financial Contract apply to this contract as well.

2025-2026 MPCS THE ZONE AFTER-SCHOOL CARE PROGRAM POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

ATTENDANCE POLICIES:

- Students not picked up from carpool by the end of dismissal time are not permitted to roam on campus. They will be checked into The Zone program and charged the daily fee. Daily rates will apply and are billed at the time of pick-up on the same day.
- The standard extended-day program hours are until 6:00 p.m. with a snack provided. You must be prompt in picking up your child after the enrolled session or **a late fee at the rate of \$2.00 per minute will be assessed**. If the child has been picked up late five times, an additional fee will be charged, and the child may be removed from the program. The front desk clock will be utilized as the official time. If late fees remain unpaid after five school days, the student may not attend extended day programs until the balance is paid in full.
- Parents will be notified immediately of any illness or serious injury to the child. If your child becomes ill and must leave the school, arrangements should be made to pick up your child within the hour. Children are not permitted to stay at the school while experiencing fever, diarrhea, vomiting, or exhibiting signs of contagious diseases or adverse reactions to any medication. A 24-hour symptom-free requirement must be met before returning to school.
- Students may not attend extended-day programs if they are not present in school on that day. The Zone is only offered on days when school is in session.
- The Zone three-day dates are pre-determined and cannot be negotiated.

GENERAL POLICIES:

- Drop-in care after school dismissal will be available when space is available. A drop-in is a student who does not regularly attend extended day programs but comes on occasion. **There must be advanced notice for any students utilizing The Zone program as a drop-in**. Arrangements must be made online, by 12:00 p.m. the day of service. Payment is due the day the student stays in The Zone.
- Payments need to be made to the business office, for students enrolled full-time in The Zone, no later than the tenth day of each month to avoid a late fee. Payments for drop-in basis are billed the same day that services are rendered.
- Withdrawal from The Zone during the year will require pro-ration of the annual fee. All other terms and conditions stated on the Tuition Financial Contract apply to this contract as well.
- For the protection of children, The Zone program follows all procedures of the school regarding severe weather, fire, physical plant problems, and structural damage. If any of these events occur, you will be contacted as soon as possible.
- Extended-day programs cannot take any responsibility for lost or broken personal articles.
- Students enrolled in The Zone program may be given the opportunity to participate in additional activities in other parts of the building (i.e. gym, library, etc.). The signature on the registration forms will serve as an in-house permission to remain on file.
- Students will need to be signed out of The Zone by a parent or other authorized person. If a child is to be released to anyone other than the parent, guardian, or other previously approved persons, the After School Care Manager is to be notified in writing of the change. Additionally, we request that you notify us in writing of any persons who are *not* allowed to pick up your child.
- If a child is not picked up by 8:00 p.m., and no communication has been received from the parents, the child will be turned over to the appropriate Cobb County authorities.

Discipline: The Zone program is an extension of the regular classroom. The approach of positive reinforcement to correct behavior will be used. Any behavior difficulties that are exhibited on a regular basis will be addressed by the lower or middle school head and may result in removal from The Zone program.
