Dear Parents,

The Eighth grade students at East Hoke Middle School are scheduled to travel to Washington, D.C. for an overnight field trip on April 15, 2025 through April 17, 2025. This experience will allow your child to gain an understanding of the history of the Nation's Capital. Students will be able to tour the National Air and Space Museum, Arlington National Cemetery, and the MLK and FDR Memorials. In addition, the itinerary encompasses academic and cultural experiences to promote lifelong learning by sparking curiosity and interest in America's foundation.

The cost of the field trip is \$504.00. There will be five installments of \$100.80, with the first payment due no later than October 25, 2024. The other dates are November 22, 2024 - December 20,2024 - January 24, 2025 - and February 27, 2025. There will be no refunds granted after the first installment and no payments accepted after the last installment date. There will be no checks accepted after January 15th. After January you must pay with cash or money order. However, you may pay the full amount of \$504.00 on or before October 25, 2024. All food arrangements will be included in the price of the trip. Students will depart for the trip on Tuesday, April 15, 2025 at 5:30am and return to campus on Thursday, April 27, 2025 at 10:30 p.m. Please make sure that you are present at least 15 minutes prior for departure and return. We hope all students will be able to partake in this learning experience.
