Feel free to send pictures on Seesaw. 😊

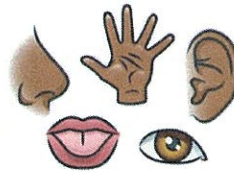
Go outside and play in the snow for 5 minutes.
