

NORTH KANSAS CITY SCHOOLS INCLEMENT WEATHER PROCEDURES



SNOW DAY

The first inclement weather day will be a traditional “snow day” with no in-person or virtual classes.

FOR STUDENTS

- Optional activities will be available online.
- No in-person Early Education programming.
- Adventure Club will operate at their snow day sites.
- Evening activities and classes will be canceled. Exceptions will be posted on the district website.

FOR STAFF

- Log in to Employee Online to confirm your work calendar.
- Teachers are not required to work, but are asked to provide activities online for students.
- Snow days may be required to be made up.

VIRTUAL (AMI) DAY

Beginning with the second snow day, we will implement up to five virtual learning (AMI) days.

FOR STUDENTS

- All students will be expected to log in and participate in online/video classes at scheduled class times.
- Adventure Club will be open at snow day sites. Students should be prepared to participate in virtual learning.

FOR STAFF

- Teachers will work from home.
- All other staff will follow existing expectations for reporting to work or working from home.
- These days would not be required to be made up.

DELAYED START

Used for days when daylight and additional time to treat roads mean safe passage is possible for students.

FOR STUDENTS

- The school day will begin two hours later and end at the regular end time.
- Early Childhood Special Education, Peers and Center-based Pre-K classes will be canceled for the entire day.
- All buses will pick up students two hours later than regular pickup times. Drop-off times will NOT change.
- Alternate stops for buses will be in effect.
- Adventure Club will operate at all schools from 6:45 a.m. to 6 p.m.

FOR STAFF

- Late start days are considered full school days and are not required to be made up.
