Did you know there are 574 Federally Recognized Tribes in the U.S.?

There are 5 tribes in Idaho; the Shoshone-Bannock, Shoshone-Paiute, Coeur d'Alene, Kootenai, and Nez Perce Tribe.

Pocatello gets its name from an Indian Chief of the Shoshoni Tribe.

The Fort Hall Indian Reservation is located in the eastern Snake River Plain of southeastern Idaho, approx. 8 miles away from Chubbuck.
