Instrumental Music Program 2024-2025



- 1. Enrollment/Length of Program:** Enrollment in the instrumental music program is open to all students in grades 4th-8th. Students (new or returning) should plan on being enrolled **full school year**.
- 2. Small Group Lessons:** All students will be assigned a lesson group of students playing with similar instruments and ability levels that will focus on improving skills specific to their instrument. **Students will be pulled-out from one class no more than once a week.** On a lesson day, students are responsible for bringing their instrument, and to attend their lesson at the correct time after asking their regular teacher for permission to go to a lesson. It will be the responsibility of the student to collect any class work missed while in lessons.

All schedules will be shared via Remind and the music bulletin board in CMS.
- 3. Instrumental Music Supplies:** All instruments, books, and supplies are supplied by the Wildwood Crest Board of Education at no cost to students and parents, and are subject to school rules and regulations as stipulated in the school handbook "Care of Property." Upon return of the instrument and music book, students will be held responsible for any damage that goes beyond normal wear and tear.
- 4. Practice At Home:** Share the gift of your instrument while at home. It will improve your sound and ability on the instrument as well. Students will not receive a report card grade for instrumental music for 2024-2025. However, music does offer academic benefits in Reading, Language, Science, Math and PE.
