# The Career & Technology Subcommittee

#### **Overview:**

The Career & Technology Subcommittee presents a comprehensive proposal for the adaptive re-use of the William Penn campus and its buildings, outlining a multifaceted approach to address various educational, vocational, and community needs. This proposal encompasses several key initiatives aimed at promoting environmental stewardship, arts and music education, cottage industries, entrepreneurial incubation, language training, alternative education, hospitality training, video gaming and artificial intelligence, public safety, and additional vocational skills.

#### **Project Scope:**

Environmental Stewardship and Climate Technology:

Creation of green technological career pathways within the Career & Technology Academy. Programs in transportation and warehouse logistics, urban wildlife conservation, aquaponics, hydro energy, and more.

Training to support solar-powered heating and power generation and other sustainable technologies.

Harrisburg Academy of Theater, Arts & Music:

Alternative educational programs for students interested in theater production, music, and related fields.

Focus on intellectual property protection and industry standards awareness.

Cottage Industry Shared Workspace:

Open workspace for crafts such as woodworking, quilting, metalworking, and pottery. Preservation of traditional craftsmanship skills.

The Entrepreneurial Incubator:

Shared workspace equipped with essential resources for aspiring entrepreneurs. Access to technology, meeting spaces, and recording facilities.

Language Academy:

Comprehensive language training academy open to students and adults. Addresses language proficiency gaps and prepares individuals for a global economy.

Alternative Education:

Reestablishment of an in-house alternative school placement program for academic and social support.

Cost-effective and efficient compared to private providers.

Hospitality/Special Event Venue and Training Space:

Industrial kitchen rental for catering operations and special events. Training programs for various roles in the service industry.

Video Gaming and Artificial Intelligence Certification Initiatives: Collaboration with Harrisburg University to develop gaming and AI programs. Prepares students for lucrative careers in the gaming and technology sectors.

PA State Police and Harrisburg Fire & Police Public Safety Academy: Creation of a law enforcement and community safety academy on the campus. Offers training in emergency response, CPR, and more, recruiting diverse candidates.

Miscellaneous Professions Training: Expansion of vocational training in various fields not currently offered in the district.

Recreational and Sports Facilities:

Preservation and income generation from the campus's historical recreational facilities. Development of roller rink, skatepark, trampoline facility, flag football training arena, and more.

## **Community Benefit:**

It should go without saying that what is proposed herein is NOT a pipe dream, but a well-thought out 5-10 year plan to preserve this historic site, and provide a model that can be duplicated across the country that demonstrates how city properties can be maintained and adapted to benefit those who have dwelled in, and supported through their generational commitment this and other similarly situated cities. ## **Project Timeline:**

- Harrisburg School District enters a 99-year lease with Turrean.
- Turrean partners with a non-profit organization to restore the original William Penn building, including a historical display and museum pieces.
- Potential use of the auditorium for performing arts programs.
- Turrean builds and subleases new construction to healthcare providers and partners with a senior housing developer for a residential community.
- Launch a public relations campaign promoting community improvement.
- The non-profit organization establishes a vocational school with health services, medical training, and student employment opportunities at the medical campus.
  Turrean, Harrisburg School District officials, City of Harrisburg officials, healthcare providers, the non-profit organization, and investors collaborate to create a redevelopment master plan.

Preserve the front portion of William Penn and demolish the back two-thirds of the building.

Our primary mission is to collaborate with the district and lease the abandoned property known as William Penn, located at 2915 N 3rd St, Harrisburg, PA 17110. Higher Level Community Outreach (HLCO) aims to renovate this property and establish a Training Academy that will not only provide job opportunities but also offer life skills training to the community. Our goal is to work with the Harrisburg district to preserve the historical value of this property and save millions of dollars in demolition costs.

## **Project Scope:**

Our plan centers around preserving the William Penn property as a historical landmark, which would enable us to retain its historical value in collaboration with the Historic Harrisburg Association. By doing so, we can significantly reduce the cost of demolition, with the remaining

portion going back to the district. HLCO is committed to covering the expenses associated with asbestos removal and decay mitigation in the front portion of the building. We will then transform this space into a Training Academy dedicated to community support.

The Training Academy will offer a wide range of opportunities to the community, including over 100 job openings, life skills training, ROTC Military, CADET Training, IT computer engineering, GED/College credits, Adult Education screenings, trade school programs, and various vocational training options. Additionally, we plan to utilize the land for the construction of a sports arena for training camps and fitness programs, as well as an aquatic center. These programs will prepare the community for the workforce and provide opportunities for personal growth and development.

## **Execution Plan:**

To bring this project to fruition, we intend to raise funds through private donations, grants, contributions from historical associations, and partnerships with organizations like the Blind People Association. We aim to complete the renovations within two years after the first year of demolition for the back portion of the building is accomplished.
