THE PLAN

Also, saves the district millions of dollars by covering the cost of the building we want to preserve. How? The cost to demolish the building would be cut in half and the remaining portion would go back to the district. The back portion of the property would be demolished by the district and the front portion would be completely renovated by our organization which we would cover the cost for removal of asbestos and decay from the building. Then transforming the building into a training academy that will support the community.

The opportunities this will bring the community is over 100+ jobs for employment. Also gives the community something to join and be a part of while also receiving the life skills to succeed. Proves training for the ROTC Military, CADET Training, IT computer engineering, and GED/College credits, Adult Education screenings, Army, trade school, band training, plumbing/Electrical training, and NASA & Robotic science.
