# Who is Capital Rebirth?

## Capital Rebirth, Inc

- $\star$  501 (c)(3) nonprofit organization
- ★ Mission: Unify & uplift Central PA by providing community-oriented events
- ★ Goal: Create solutions to the problems within our community
- ★ Core focuses:
  - Health and Wellness (Youth Flag Football
     League, Superhero Day)
  - Education (Community Workshops, Panel Discussions)
  - Entertainment (Talent Festival, Superhero Day)





### How we got here...

- ★ Simpson's vision to restore the building (2012)
- ★ School went up for sale (2019) = opportunity
- ★ Pitched to a few. Support was resounding.
- ★ Community Outreach
  - Online Community Forums "Town Hall Meetings"
  - Petition = nearly 8,500 signatures
  - Letter of Support from a former Mayor
  - Interviews with local news, papers, & podcasts

## **Projected Development Cost**

#### **Building Restored**

- ★ Harrisburg School District projection:\$80-\$100 Million
  - William Penn is 250,000 sqft: 5.7 acres
- ★ Other phases not included

#### Demolished (6 Columns Rebuilt)

- ★ Local Construction Company (25 building samples) \$5 million
- ★ Sports Complex \$25 million (261,360 sq ft) (6 acres)
- ★ Housing 80 Units 1&2 BR \$25 million (100,00 sq ft) (2.2 acres)
- ★ Vocational Training Facility \$7 million (100,000 sq ft) (2.2 acres)
- ★ Medical Center \$5 million (10,000 sq ft)
- ★ Child Care Center \$8 million (21,780 sq ft)
- ★ Resource Center \$ 2 million (25,000 sq ft)
- ★ Restaurants/Retail \$5 million (43,560 sq ft) (1 acres)

## **Development Phases**

Phases & Buildings

- ★ Depends on Rezoning Area
- ★ Depends on Codes
- ★ Phase 1: USDA Vo-tech/Career Classrooms (3-5 year plan)
- ★ Phase 1: USDA Medical Facility (3-5 year plan)
- ★ Phase 2: Depends on funding (3-10 year plan)

#### **Vo-Tech & Career Classrooms**

- ★ Adult Education: GED, Certification Programs (electric, plumbing, dry wall, welding, etc.)
  - Operated by local organizations, businesses and individuals
- ★ Company's have location to train (PPL, UGI, Comcast etc.)
- ★ Local colleges and universities can use
- ★ After-school programs: Operated by local organizations, businesses and individuals
- ★ Summer programs
  - Operated by local organizations, businesses and individuals

## Harrisburg School District Vocational School

- ★ Locked into contract with Dauphin County Tech (years to come)
  - o (Open to District, once in position, to operate its own DC Tech)
- ★ Staffing, DC Tech Contract End

Steele Elementary School (70 staff)


Current Vacancies (98)

- ★ Indoor 200m Track
- ★ Host local, regional and national events
- ★ Harrisburg sports programs will have access.
- ★ 1 turf field for soccer/football



#### Turf Field

#### 2nd Floor of Sports Complex

- ★ Equivalent to Soccer/Football Field
- ★ Youth/Adult Sporting Leagues, Training, Tournaments, and Events
- ★ Youth/Adult Football/Soccer Games
- ★ Local High Schools Practice Site
- ★ Spectator Bleachers
- ★ Scoreboard






# Spooky Nook $\rightarrow$ Notice the impact down the road

#### ★ Economic Impact

O Based on the numbers from that study as well as the increase in traffic since then, it is estimated that Spooky Nook has created over 13,000 jobs (direct, indirect, and induced) and generated \$379 million in hotel revenue (as of June 2023) for the surrounding area.



# **Cultural Diversity**

- ★ A community's strength is increased through recreational activities that allow people to share cultural & ethnic differences.






# Safe Space

- ★ Harrisburg, PA's ethnic composition in 2017
  - 23.8k African Americans residents
  - 10k Hispanic or Latino residents
  - o 2.4k Asian residents
  - o 36 American Indian residents
  - 22 Native Hawaiian & Other Pacific Islander residents
- ★ Provide respect & emotional security for individuals from historically marginalized groups through:
  - o Recreation
  - Resources
  - Counselors
  - Services
  - Food





# Increased Public Safety & Reduced Crime Rate

- ★ Educational opportunities leads to less crime
- ★ 365 Day Operation = recreational/educational alternatives for residents
- ★ Adults able to further their education & obtain certification that can lead to more financially stable employment.
- ★ Youth has opportunity to explore career paths of their interest.
