Item 4 | Citizen Comment - Penny Whitney- community member/SCS beach staff

- Sent an email to the town council about adjusting parking fees. Recommended the following schedule for fees.

- \$10 from 5:30-8am and 4-6pm
- \$20 from 9-4
- Memorial day weekend to Labor Day
- No change in the fee for trailers and RVs
- No change in the fee for resident or non-resident beach passes

Item 5 | Beach Environment- Recap/proposals for dogs and review fees

Rick - Increase will recover some of the cost to maintain beaches

Trish - Bathrooms and other services are in need of repair and increased fees will help to cover the cost of these facilities.

Emily - Don't raise fees, even them out. One for non-residents, residents and a beach pass.

Todd - Wants more rangers and can pull from the beach reserve funds if beaches don't have a great income year.
