ACT State Testing

The ACT is a college entrance exam that measures students' academic readiness for college. Each February, AHS juniors may take the test one time for free. The ACT assesses four key areas: English, Math, Reading, and Science and takes roughly four hours to complete. Many colleges and universities use ACT scores as part of their admissions and financial aid process.

Opt-Out Option:

While we encourage all students to take advantage of this free opportunity if college is one of their goals, we understand that it may not be the right fit for all students. Some families may wish to opt their student out of the exam. If you prefer that your student does not participate in the free ACT test offered for juniors at our school, please indicate your decision by completing the form below and returning it to the school. Your student could opt to take any national ACT test on a Saturday, but they will have to register online and pay for that test themselves.
