# **Overall Close Up Program Curriculum**

**Central Question:** What can we learn from history to become better citizens today?

#### **Close Up:**

- Uses D.C. as a living classroom to explore our democracy.
- Operates on a small-group model (1 program instructor per 20-25 students).
- Encourages students to learn and deliberate with their peers through civil discourse.
- Gets students thinking about important foundational questions like, "What is the proper size and scope of government?"

# **Supervision and Security**

- 24/7 supervision including a Program Leader, Program Instructors and Night Monitors on each hotel hallway throughout the night (10 PM 6 AM).
- Program Instructors have 120+ hours of training, certification in CPR/First Aid, criminal background checks, and all staff have been vaccinated against COVID-19.
- Students wear Close Up name tags with an emergency hotline number that is staffed 24/7.
- Partnership with Georgetown Medical Center

### Price and What's Included

Total price is \$1000, which includes:

- Round-trip coach bus transportation to, from, and around D.C.
- Hotel accommodations (two students per room)
- Three meals per day on full program days
- Academic materials and instruction
- 24-hour supervision, including night monitors
- All admission fees, tips, and gratuities
- Specialized access to Georgetown University Medical Center
- Close Up backpack, water bottle, and guidebook

### What's Not Included

- Travel insurance is optional but STRONGLY encouraged. Close Up's recommended provider is Travel Guard, but families may choose their own provider.
- Extra spend money for souvenirs
