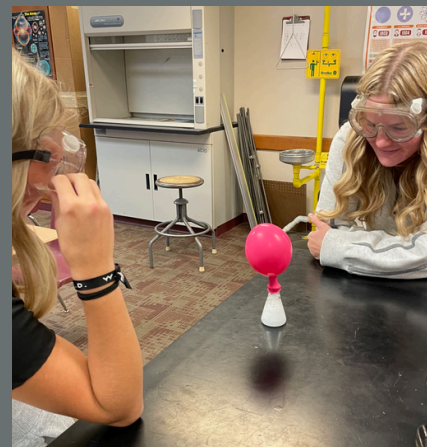


## ELEMENTARY NEWS
