

## **Michindoh Outdoor Education School Clothing and Equipment List for Students**

\* Please note: You will be limited to one suitcase and one bedroll. Please label all belongings with your name and school on them.

**Bedding:** Be prepared for cool nights  
You will need to bring a sleeping bag or bed roll (2-3 blankets and sheets). Please place your sleeping gear in plastic in order to keep it from getting wet. Bring a pillow.

**Clothing:** We suggest students bring old but clean clothing. Clothing should be marked  
One pair of pajamas or something comfortable to sleep in  
Two pair of shoes with laces  
Daily change of socks and under clothing (extra socks are recommended)  
Heavy and light shirts  
Jacket and/or Sweater  
Raincoat and waterproof shoes or boots  
Two or three pairs of jeans or sweatpants- we prefer no dresses/skirts/leggings  
Shorts (must be above 50 degrees) fingertip length from knee/ school appropriate  
**In winter:** gloves, hats, boots, coats, snow pants, and layers of clothing are essential  
**No: tank tops, short shorts or other clothing that would not be appropriate for school (even on “dress down” days).**

**Toiletries:** Personal hygiene items  
Toothpaste and toothbrush  
Soap, shampoo, and conditioner  
Bath towel and washcloth  
Comb or brush  
Deodorant  
Water bottle or plastic drinking cup  
In season: sun screen, ChapStick, insect repellent (non-aerosol)

**Additional:** Label all items  
Flashlight  
Stationary and stamps, pencil  
Camera (disposable preferred, digital is allowed)  
Drawstring backpack (for carrying items)  
Water Bottle (preferred)

**Please leave at home:**

Bedding: You will need to bring a sleeping bag or sheets and blankets. You may bring a pillow if you would like. Please place your sleeping gear in a plastic bag in order to keep it from getting wet. Be prepared for cool nights.

Clothing: We suggest that you bring old but clean clothing. You will be assisting in some classes so always be prepared for getting dirty. Bring jeans, shorts, long sleeved shirts, and plenty of socks. You will have to decide what clothing you want to bring depending on the time of year that you are coming to camp. Bring two pairs of shoes and a pair of boots if possible. If it is raining, snowing, or cold, we will continue with our programs outside. Rain gear and a jacket of some sort are highly recommended for your stay here.

Toiletries: You will need to bring everything necessary for the bathroom and shower. Some examples are: toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, tissues, towel, wash cloth, deodorant, water bottle or plastic cup, ChapStick, sun screen, and insect repellent (non-aerosol).

Optional: If you would like, you may also bring a flashlight, stationary, stamps, and a camera. We do ask that if you have an alarm clock and watch to please bring them with you. You will be responsible for waking up the campers each morning. There are electrical outlets in the cabin for you to plug in your alarm clock. You may bring a hair dryer that you would not mind sharing with the students. We do have vending machines along with a game room that is available for you to use during your breaks. If you are interested in using them you will need to bring some money. However, please realize that Michindoh is not responsible for lost or stolen property. On the last evening of camp, we will have a square dance. Please feel free to bring along overalls, straw/cowboy hats, or any other clothing appropriate for the dance.
