PUBLIC SAFETY CLASSES

CPR/BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS)

Learn life-saving skills in this CPR class, including rescue breathing for adults, children, and infants, and how to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).

EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONDER (EMR)

This course covers all aspects, responsibilities, and duties for providing emergency care. Upon certification you will be able to provide direct patient care in a variety of medical emergency situations.

FIRST AID & MORE
