1. Oxford Middle School will:

a. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables students to meet Mississippi's academic achievement standards as follows:

Oxford Middle School will meet regularly in Professional Learning Communi4es, core subjects. Every meeting will revolve around asking and answering four essen4al ques4ons: 1) What is it every student must learn; 2) How will we know when students have learned?; 3) How will we respond when some students don't learn?; 4) How can we enrich the learning for students who are already proficient?; 5) How can we improve the capacity of each individual and team to help more students learn? Through PLCs, we will collaborate on planning, ensuring a guaranteed and viable curriculum for ALL students, administer common formative assessments at least four 4mes a year and each PLC will evaluate data from common formative assessments.

b. Hold parent-teacher conferences during which this compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual student's academic achievement.

Oxford Middle School faculty, administration, and counselor will be available to meet with parents and discuss individual student achievement before school, during school, or ager school at the convenience of the parent. Each faculty member will be afforded at least one planning block per day. We request that parents schedule a conference with our school counselor.

c. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's progress.

Parents will be provided progress reports on the fourth week of each term. Report cards will be issued at the end of each term. Teachers will communicate with parents as needed to discuss student achievement.

d. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.

Oxford Middle School faculty, administration, and counselor will be available to meet with parents and discuss individual student achievement before school, during school, or ager school at the convenience of the parent. Each faculty member will be afforded at least one planning block per day. We request that parents schedule a conference with our school counselor.

e. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer in their child's school and to participate in school activities. (Describe when and how parents may volunteer, participate, and observe classroom activities.)

Parents will be encouraged to share their exper4se at Oxford Middle School. Parents are encouraged to volunteer in school ac4vi4es and functions such as classroom activities, field trips, and various other functions such as 1:1 deployment and academic opportunity classes. Parents serve as mentors and tutors for students who are having difficulty academically and socially. Mentors counsel students weekly and tutors assist students biweekly on their homework assignments. Parents will be encouraged to participate in the activities of their middle school children.

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2. Parents will support our children's learning in the following ways:

- Let the teacher know if my child has any problems with learning.
- Ensure my child reads at least 20 minutes daily.
- Help my child see how to use reading and math to pursue his/her interests and goals.
- Check student PowerSchool portal for grades, assignments, and daily announcements.
- Request addi4onal mee4ngs with staff as needed.
- **3. Students** will share the responsibility to improve academic achievement:

Students Pledge: I will

- Let my teacher and family know if I need help.
- Be an ac4ve par4cipant in class.
- Read on my own at least 20 minutes daily.
- Work on my math and reading skills at home, using materials my teacher sends home.
- Write down my assignments, do my homework daily, and turn it in when due.
- Assist parents in use of PowerSchool.
- Encourage parents to communicate with teachers.
