

Q. HOW DO I ENROLL AND PAY FOR CLASSES?

Q. WHEN IS REGISTRATION?

January 6-19 Late enrollment: January 20-24 (\$35 late fee will apply)

* NO ENROLLMENTS ARE ACCEPTED AFTER January 24, 2025 (at 11:59 PM).

Q. What is the best enrollment option for ensuring class admittance? Online enrollment is accepted on a first come, first served basis. ENROLLMENTS ARE NOT ACCEPTED BY PHONE.

Q. When do classes begin?

Classes are held one day a week for 8 weeks long (some exceptions). Enrichment classes for Spring 2024 begin the week of February 3. There are no enrichment classes when on holidays, professional development days, or early release days.

Q. Is bus transportation provided?

No. Due to safety, elementary students are **PROHIBITED from walking or biking**. If your child attends extended care, then the instructor will walk your child to Extended Care after class.

Q. May I enroll my child for classes held at another campus?

No, for time management and to ensure safety, students may only enroll in classes at their respective campuses.
