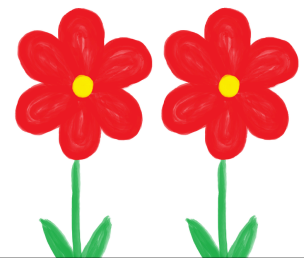
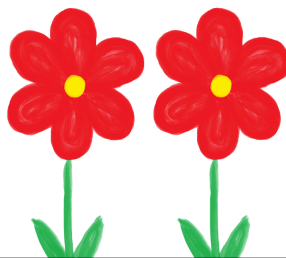
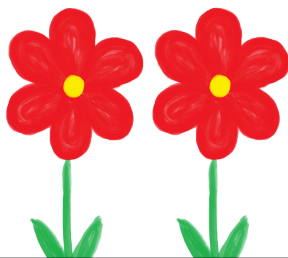

Q. WHEN IS REGISTRATION?

Q. What is the best enrollment option for ensuring class admittance?

Online enrollment is accepted on a first come, first served basis.

Q. When do classes begin?

Classes are held one day a week for 8 weeks long (some exceptions).

Enrichment classes for Spring 2024 begin the week of February 3. There are no enrichment classes when on holidays, professional development days, or early release days.

Q. Is bus transportation provided?

No. Due to safety, elementary students are **PROHIBITED** from *walking or biking*.
If your child attends extended care, then the instructor will walk your child to Extended Care after class.
